

Ready, set, enroll!

Here's what you'll need to enroll in a 2021 health insurance plan:

Marketplace account information

If you don't have an account yet, create one at **HealthCare.gov**. Keep your new username and password in a safe place – you'll need it when you re-enroll next year.

Personal information

For every member of your household who is enrolling:

- A social security card or permanent resident card
- W-2 tax form or proof of income
- Employer address and phone number

Current health information

- List of doctors to see which plans cover them
- List of medicines to see which plans cover them, and at what cost
