

## 2021 RCS Cheerleading Tryouts

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Your child has expressed interest in trying out to be an RCS Cheerleader. Being an RCS Cheerleader is a great honor that comes with responsibility and is a commitment by both the child and the parent. Please understand that the commitment required is time, dedication, and money. The responsibility of time includes attending practice, tumbling class, games, and maintaining the grades. The responsibility of money includes paying for tumbling classes, cheer camp, camp wear, and uniform apparel. Please review the attached guidelines carefully. If you agree to abide by these guidelines, please sign the bottom portion and have your child bring to try-outs and turn in to Laken Russell on July 20. This form must be returned in order for your child to try out. Physicals are not required to tryout, but the child must be covered by his/her own insurance.

Tryout date will be Tuesday, July 20th to learn materials and be judged for tryouts beginning at 10:00 and ending at 12:00. Students will need a ride home promptly at the end of try-outs. Pick up will be at the back gym doors.

Before trying out for cheerleading, students must meet the following categories.....  
Attendance (must be 85% or higher), discipline, and academics (must have a C average).  
Also, those trying out must have teacher evaluations turned in before tryouts.
