



Thank you for booking your Health Related Fitness Assessment with us, please keep a copy of your booking and bring it with you on the day of your test.

Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your assessment time, allowing plenty of time for travelling to CWS. If the candidate is late, we will endeavour to allocate a new time on your test date but this cannot be guaranteed; you will be advised accordingly on the day. If the candidate is unable to attend the test on the day due to illness or for another reason, we will not be able to accommodate you on an alternative date and the candidate will no longer be part of the Health Related Fitness Assessment Application process.

The candidate should be suitably dressed for performing sporting activities, which will take place indoors. We recommend shorts, t-shirt, indoor trainers and jumper or tracksuit in the event of inclement weather. We also recommend that the candidate brings a bottle of water. Please note that there will be no changing facilities on site. No other equipment will be required. Please do not bring mobile phones.

We strongly advise that you make your way to Coombe Wood School on foot or on public transport. We are located opposite Lloyds Park tram stop and there are a number of buses that run along Croham Road a short walk from the school.

Please note that there is limited parking on site and the car park is subject to parking charges. You must register your vehicle at reception to qualify for free parking otherwise you will be charged by the operating company. Parking is at owners risk, Coombe Wood School does not accept any responsibility for charges incurred.

It is not possible for parents or guardians to wait on site whilst the assessments take place.

The test will take approximately 45 minutes.

It is advised that the candidate refrains from strenuous exercise the evening before the test and is well rested in preparation.

COVID - advice on COVID related queries will be provided nearer the time when we have been advised by Government as to the current protocols.

Once all tests have been completed you will receive an email informing you as to whether your child be eligible to be considered for admission under the Health Related Fitness Assessment criterion.

The collection point will be clearly identified on site.

If you are not collecting your child after the assessment please provide a written note to say that you are happy for your child to make their own way home. We will not release students without identifying an adult or without written correspondence.
