

Graduation Ceremonies (Participation)

The Board believes that completion of the requirements for a diploma from the District is an achievement that improves the community as well as the individual. Therefore, the Board wishes to recognize that achievement annually in a publicly held graduation ceremony.

Students must have successfully completed all high school graduation requirements and obligations in order to participate in the graduation ceremony, except as provided below:

1. A foreign exchange student may be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremonies at the discretion of the school administration, upon successful completion of the school year.
2. Exceptions may be approved by the Board in unusual circumstances, upon recommendation of the school administration.

The school administration shall notify all students of the requirements and obligations that must be met in order to participate in the graduation exercises. Individual students who are not or may not be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremonies, and their parents(s)/guardians(s), shall be notified.
