Assignment for Students Entering Third Grade 2021

Students entering **third grade** in September are required to read two books over the summer and complete activities relating to each book. All students must read Horrible Harry Moves Up to Third by Suzy Kline and complete two tasks for that novel. All students will then read one nonfiction book of their choice, and complete a small assignment. Both portions will count as project grades. Please see below for the details regarding each book report.

1. Assignment 1

Horrible Harry Moves up to Third Grade: ALL students will read this novel and complete both of the following activities:

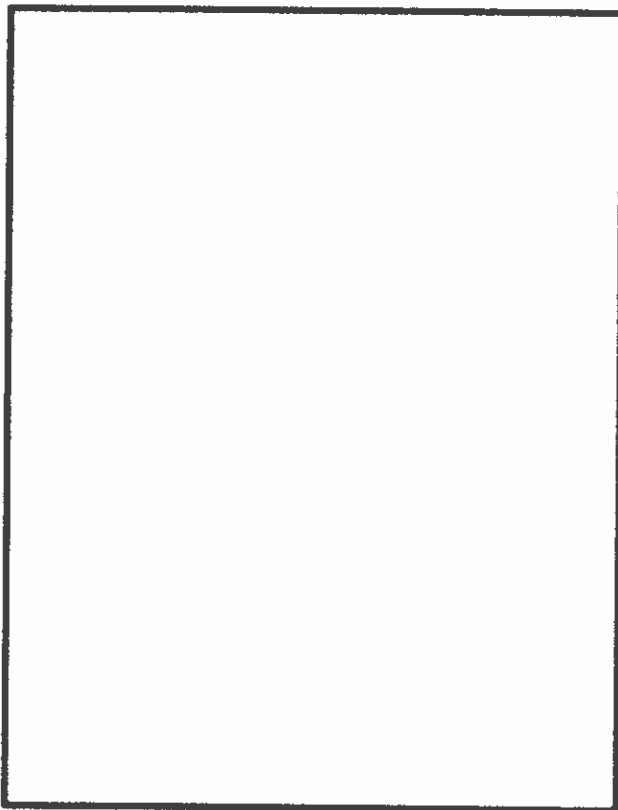
- Movie Poster (See directions on following pages.)

2. Assignment 2

- *Non-Fiction Book Report*: Read a non-fiction book of your choice. Complete the graphic organizer about your book. (See attached.)

Assignment 1: Horrible Harry Moves Up to Third Grade Movie Poster & Summary Book Report

Your assignment is to create a poster related to the book, Horrible Harry Moves Up To Third Grade. Think about visiting a movie theater. When you visit, there are posters to grab your attention of movies that are coming out. You will do a similar assignment, but will create a "movie poster" for the book, Horrible Harry Moves Up to Third Grade, pretending as if the movie will be coming out shortly. The poster must represent events that occurred in the book. Use the space below to plan your poster! Then, follow the below instructions on your poster board.



Your Poster Must Include:

- Book Title
- Author
- Your Name
- Colorful Illustration
- Quotes which recommend Movie
- Movie Rating
- Movie Tagline
- Movie Cast
- Premiere Date
- Number of Stars

Don't Forget! Your Poster must be colorful and creatively designed.
Make sure to do your best work and have fun with it!

More Poster Information:

- Your poster title should be the title of our book, Horrible Harry Moves Up to Third Grade.
- The author's name should be neatly written below the title.
- Please write your name on the bottom corner of your poster.
- Choose a space within your poster to illustrate your favorite scene from the book. Make it colorful!
- Write a brief review of the book, explaining why you do or do not recommend it.
- Rate the book with either a "G" or "PG" movie rating and write your rating on the poster.
- Create a "movie tagline" for the book. A tagline should be a quick sentence giving a clue about what the book is about to make others want to read the book. (Example: "To infinity..and beyond!" -- Toy Story)
- Movie Cast: Create a space on your poster to record the names of the main characters of the book. This is your "movie cast".
- Create a date for your movie to come out! Write it somewhere neatly on your poster. Example: "Premiere Date: September 3, 2021"
- Number of Stars: Rate the book from a 1-star rating to a 5-star rating. 1 star would mean you did not like this book, and 5-stars would mean you loved it! Draw all five stars, and then color the amount of stars to represent your vote.
- Complete the summary page that follows.
