Example using the New Grading Scale:

Step 1: Multiply the Point Value times the Credits for each course.

Step 2: Add the sum of those points, in this case, it equals 109.

Step 3: Add the number of credits, in this case, they equal 35.

Step 4: Divide the sum of the points by the number of credits. $109/35 = 3.1142$

Step 5: Round to two decimal places. 3.11

This is the GPA only for the first marking period. It is not a student's cumulative GPA, which is their GPA from the beginning of freshman year to the present. The cumulative GPA is calculated twice a year, after the first semester, and at the end of the year.
