Most importantly, the recipient of this award has demonstrated a passion for the school and, like Jordie, displayed through his/her actions a deep understanding of the values represented by the jersey stripes: courage, honesty, integrity, loyalty, and sportsmanship.

Scholarship Description

The Jordie Maine '79 Scholarship is open to both current 8th graders at SCH Academy and applicants for 9th grade in '22-'23. The winner will receive a \$5,000 annual merit based grant.

Grade nine applicants will also consider all material submitted during the application process including Student classroom visit, Standardized testing, Teacher recommendations, and School Transcript. *The winner will be notified in mid-January.*
