
Introduction

Your teacher has created your tests in Eduphoria to be taken in an online environment. This guide provides direction on how to take these online tests and take advantage of the extra support features. You can access these online tests on a laptop, desktop, or tablet device.

Logging In to Eduphoria


Follow the instructions below to log in to your online test through Eduphoria:

1. Open a browser window and enter the district online testing link.
2. Log in with your Student ID number and password (the password is set by the system administrator or the teacher).

3. Select the appropriate test. If you are not sure which test to select, confirm with your teacher.



Answering Questions

Follow these steps to make sure you are answer questions the right way on your test.

1. Answer each question by selecting an answer and then selecting **Next**.
2. To navigate between questions, use the Question Number or use the **Previous** and **Next** buttons at the bottom of the screen.
3. Once you have finished answering questions, select **Review & Submit**.



Submitting Your Test

If you skipped any questions, they will show up on this appear as "unanswered."

1. Answer any questions that are labeled unanswered. Select the red box containing the question number to go back to that question.
2. Once all questions have been answered, select Submit to Score.



Eduphoria's Online Testing has many helpful features for taking your online test. These include basic features like a calculator and notepad, and support features like zoom and text-to-speech.

Basic Features


Exit

If you cannot complete your test in one sitting, select **Exit**. Your progress will be saved and you can return at a later point to complete it.




Calculator

A **Calculator Icon** will appear if your teacher has enabled one for your test. To turn on the calculator, select the **Calculator Icon**. To turn it off, select the icon again.




Highlighting

To highlight parts of your test, select the text you wish to highlight and select the **Highlight Icon**. To delete the highlighting, select the **Clear Highlight Icon**.



Notepad


The notepad allows you to take notes about questions. Your teacher can see your notes and they will not affect your grade. When you select **ADD NOTE** from the toolbar, a notepad option will appear in the bottom right corner.



You can either minimize the notes box or delete the note. In addition, you will have the option to add a note to each question. The notepad will not be shown until you select **ADD NOTE**. A note of up to 500 characters is supported.

Eliminating Answer Choices

You can eliminate, or remove, answer choices that you don't want to use by selecting the "-" symbol next to the answer choice. If you change your mind, select the "-" symbol again, to reactivate that answer choice.





LockDown Browser



Support Features

Text to Speech

Text to Speech is a feature that will read aloud, or narrate, the test questions and answer choices to help you understand them. If Text to Speech has been enabled for you, the Speak Icon appears next to each question and answer choice.


Select the Speak Icon to hear the questions and answers read aloud.



The SPEAK OPTIONS allow you to adjust the rate of speech and volume of the Text to Speech.




When you select text with your mouse, a pop-up menu will appear. This allows you to both highlight the selected text and have the selection read aloud, if Text to Speech is enabled. You can also pause and stop as needed while listening, all from the pop-up menu.




Zoom

The ZOOM option allows you to increase the size of the text in the online testing work area to improve the visibility and make it easier for you to read. Selecting the **ZOOM** magnifying glass on the toolbar will activate the zoom function, which includes 7 levels.

Color Contrast

You can choose color contrast options by selecting **COLOR THEME** from the toolbar. We offer the same color options as the online STAAR assessments (Texas state standards test). Select the color theme from the options available that best supports your needs.
