## ENGLISH 9:

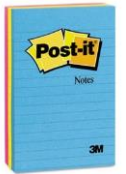
**NOTEBOOK** – Purchase one large enough to last a full semester so that your student may keep all English notes in one notebook

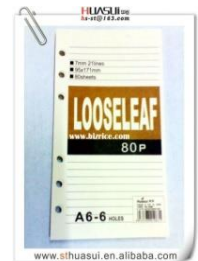


## SCIENCE 9:
