## ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY

The PK-12 campus of Dundee Central School is nestled between two scenic Finger Lakes - Keuka Lake and Seneca Lake.

Although they are housed in one building, the elementary school and the junior/senior high school maintain their distinct identities. The elementary school is extremely proud of their efforts to continuously monitor the alignment of curriculum, instruction and assessments. The programs are responsive to the needs of all students, including a communitybased UPK program, full day kindergarten, a wide range of academic enrichment and support services, and a commitment to students with special needs.

The Dundee Junior/Senior High School supports a schedule that requires students to take a rigorous course schedule, and programs are offered in a multitude of ways. Advanced Placement courses, and Gemini college courses are offered to students in several academic areas. We also work in close collaboration with Wayne-Finger Lakes BOCES to support Career and Technical Education opportunities.

Dundee Central School is a small school with big school pride. We enjoy overwhelming support from our community. We work in tandem to mold responsible, caring and academically prepared future citizens. With the support of the Dundee Community, the District was proud to offer in-person instruction five days a week during the 2020-2021 school year.

## THE COMMUNITY

Situated in the hills of the New York State Finger Lakes region, Dundee Central School enjoys being the center of attention in a community of 5,000 people. Our rural environment allows our school to often be the center of community activities and student aspirations. The school district is the largest employer in the Hamlet of Dundee.
