Purpose of ESSER III

- American Rescue Plan (**ARP**) Act through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief III (ESSER III) Fund.
- Purpose
 - Respond to the pandemic
 - Address student learning loss needs



Accessibility to Funds

- Crandall ISD plans on accepting the funds
 - For the amount of \$2,330,624.24
- $\frac{2}{3}$ of funds available now
- Remainder of funds available in fall
- Utilization of Region 10 for grant management



Grant Requirements

- Public Notice - Kaufman Herald and District Website
- Survey to all student families - June 23
- Data Collection - ongoing through July 15
- Submit ESSER III application - Due July 16
- Post plans on website



Use of Funds

Four required domains:

20% set-aside to address the academic impact of lost instructional time.

Health & Safety as related to COVID (CDC guidance)

Interventions implemented will respond to academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, and particularly those students disproportionately impacted by COVID-19.
