

**Pre-K/Kindergarten Transition Plan**

- Registration begins in the spring for the upcoming school year.
- If a student is involved in DART, transition meetings occur with DART, parents/guardians, and CVPS beginning in January.
- If a student is involved in DART and qualifies for school-age special education services, an IEP is created beginning in April for the upcoming school year.
- Kindergarten screening occurs for all registered students in the spring for the upcoming school year.
- Students are assigned to classrooms through a Mega Meeting placement process.
- All students and parents/guardians are invited to a Kindergarten Orientation and Kindergarten Readiness program before the school year begins.
- When the school year begins, kindergarten students have a gradual entry process for the first days of school where additional screening occurs. New students receive a full kindergarten screening during this time.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade/3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Transition Plan**

- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students attend an orientation of CVIS in May/June of each year. In addition, CVIS staff visit 2<sup>nd</sup> grade classrooms.
- Parents/guardians provide placement information about student learning to the Mega Meeting (student placement) team.
- CVPS staff members meet with CVIS staff to help with student groupings, placement and ability levels.
- CVIS hosts a 3<sup>rd</sup> grade orientation prior to the start of the school year for students and parents/guardians.

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade/6<sup>th</sup> Grade Transition Plan**

- CVMS Counselors present to 5th grade students about the MS and options for 6th grade.
- CVMS prepares a virtual tour of the MS for students and parents to view virtually.
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade students attend a virtual orientation and move-up day at CVMS in May/June of each year.
- Parents/Guardians may request individual tours during the month of August to help with their child's transition and/or to provide a foundation for the family.
- CVIS staff members meet with CVMS staff to help with student groupings and ability levels.
- CVMS hosts a parent/guardian night for incoming students.
