- Currently enrolled families can transfer to Owatonna Online with a simple form (K-5 or 6-12)
- ★ New families can enroll through central enrollment via an online format. Be sure to have the following information to begin.
 - Immunizations records for each child
 - Student records from previous school (if available)
 - Name, address, telephone and fax number of the last school attended
 - Birth certificate or official certificate of age (kindergarten enrollment only)
