School Supplies

- Pens/pencils
 - Notebooks
 - Folders
 - Binders
 - Calculator/graphic calculator
 - Hand sanitizer

Bedding

- XL Twin sized sheets
 - Mattress cover (80 inches/extra-long)
 - Blanket/comforter
 - Pillows & pillow cases

Clothing

All clothing, blankets, linen, athletic wear, etc. should be labeled or have nametag attached.

Miscellaneous

- Shower caddy
- Towels and washcloths

- Desk lamp/floor lamp (non-halogen)

- Fan (for air circulation)
- Wastebasket
- Surge protector/power strip
- Small rug
- Additional school supplies**
- Sunscreen and bug repellent

Basic supplies are available for purchase in School Store.

Athletic Attire/Equipment

- Gym shorts
- Sweatshirt/Sweat pants
- White athletic socks
- Reusable water bottle
- Sneakers (some students have one pair for general outside use and another for sports)
- Athletic shoes: The specific type of footwear needed for each sport. Any reputable brand will probably fall within the rules.
- Mouth guard: all boys who play football, hockey, or lacrosse at any level must use a good quality mouth guard. We require boys to use them for ALL practices. Mouth guards are also sold by the athletic department.

Additional Items to Consider

- Snacks/drinks
- Radio/speakers

Prohibited Items

- Refrigerators
- Microwaves, hot pots, rice cookers
- Irons
- Hair dryers
- Space heaters, lava lamps
- Tobacco, e-cigarettes, vapes, drugs, and alcoholic paraphernalia
- Pets
- Inappropriate posters/reading material
- Monitors larger than 32 inches
- Televisions
- Air conditioners
- Couches & Futons

- Cooking appliances
 - Medications, “Over-the-counter” cold medications, sleep aids, etc. (All prescription medications must be stored in Health Center)
 - Any substance banned by the NCAA
