

Lodi USD Music Guidelines and Protocols, 7/23/2021

Until further notice all wind, choir, and full/partial band shall occur under the following guidelines:

- 1. Bell covers should be used for all woodwinds and brass and should be made with a multi-layer cover with the center layer being made of MERV-13 filter material, or a 3-layer surgical style mask using an ASTM F2100 or GB/T32610 standard.
- 2. Singers and instrumentalists should wear a well-fitted 3-layer surgical-style mask that meets the ASTM F2100 or GB/T32610 standard to reduce aerosol emission. Instrumental players may have a slit in their mask to allow the insertion of their mouthpiece. The slitted mask does not replace the instrumentalist's usual mask and is only used when actively playing their instrument.
- 3. All instruments may be used indoors, as follows
 - a. Masking per guideline #2
 - b. Minimum of three (3) feet of spacing between participants, ideal spacing is six (6) feet
- 4. Performing arts activities should happen on a reduced schedule:
 - a. Indoors 30-minute maximum restriction with Medify air filter running with full ionization feature
 - b. Outdoors no restrictions
- 5. Rehearsal space recommendations in order of preference:
 - a. Outdoor rehearsals, using individual mitigation techniques described above in Guidelines 1 & 2.
 - b. Indoors in classrooms with Medify air filter running with full ionization feature
 - c. Indoors MP Rooms and Gymnasiums maintain three (3) foot spacing minimum
- 6. Practice good hygiene by washing hands, using sanitizers, and preventing uncontrolled spit valve release.
- 7. As of the date of this posting, advance Cabinet approval is required for any in-person, live event
