



Jesus gave us the great commandment to love God with all our heart and love and care for each other. In the Sermon on the Mount he tells us, “Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth” (Mt 5:5). The definition of meekness is humility toward God and towards others. It is having the *right* or the *power* to do something but refraining for the benefit of someone else. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love” ([Ephesians 4:2](#)). Jesus, being the very nature of God, had the right to do whatever He wanted, but, for our sake, He humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

Let us love God and our neighbor, let us be meek and model the humility of Jesus. Small sacrifices go a long way in portraying our love to others. Wearing our masks in Church, is a small sacrifice that will allow those that are still very vulnerable, especially our elderly and those with autoimmune deficiencies, to continue to attend Mass and receive the body and blood of Christ.

The ADOM policy for gathering in liturgical or other spaces within the parishes, continues to require the use of masks and social distancing. Groups or in person ministry meetings may take place with proper social distancing and proper use of masks.

Adhering to CDC guidelines about mask wearing for vaccinated adults, the archdiocesan policy states: adults must wear masks even outdoors when students are present; and indoors when children/ students or any other adults that are not fully vaccinated are present in the same room or indoor space.



Jesús nos dio el gran mandamiento de amar a Dios con todo nuestro corazón y amarnos y cuidarnos unos a otros. En el Sermón de la Montaña nos dice: “Bienaventurados los mansos, porque ellos heredarán la tierra” (Mt 5, 5). La definición de mansedumbre es humildad hacia Dios y hacia los demás. Es tener el derecho o el poder de hacer algo, pero abstenerse en beneficio de otra persona. Sea completamente humilde y gentil; sed pacientes, soportándonos en amor” (Efesios 4: 2). Jesús, siendo la naturaleza misma de Dios, tenía el derecho de hacer lo que quisiera, pero, por nuestro bien, se humilló al hacerse obediente hasta la muerte, ¡incluso la muerte de cruz!

Amemos a Dios y al prójimo, seamos mansos y modelemos la humildad de Jesús. Los pequeños sacrificios contribuyen en gran medida a demostrar nuestro amor por los demás. Usar nuestras máscaras en la Iglesia, es un pequeño sacrificio que permitirá que aquellos que aún son muy vulnerables, especialmente las personas mayores y aquellos con deficiencias autoinmunes, sigan asistiendo a Misa y reciban el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo.

La postura de la Arquidiócesis para reunirse en espacios litúrgicos u otros dentro de las parroquias, continúa requiriendo el uso de máscaras y distanciamiento social. Los grupos o reuniones ministeriales en persona pueden tener lugar con el distanciamiento social adecuado y el uso adecuado de máscaras.

Siguiendo las pautas de la CDC sobre el uso de máscaras para adultos vacunados, la arquidiócesis establece que los adultos deben usar máscaras cuando hay niños o cualquier otro adulto que no esté completamente vacunado en la misma habitación o espacio interior, incluso al aire libre cuando los niños están presents.

Greetings in the Lord!

On July 26 we celebrate the Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. Throughout the Church we celebrate the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly to remind people of the great blessing our grandparents and elderly are for our families and for society.

One could only imagine the role Saints Joaquim and Anne played in Jesus' life. Most likely Joaquim and Anne helped Mary and Joseph with Jesus' upbringing, education, and faith formation.



We have come a long way since Jesus' time but some things remain the same. Grandparents today continue to help their sons and daughters to raise their children. In fact, there are lots of grandparents who take their grandchildren to school, sports, artistic activities, baby sit for them, cook for them, and most important who transmit the Catholic Faith to them.

Many Eastern cultures prioritize the family unit and value elders with the utmost respect. They base this practice on the Confucian Filial piety, which calls for taking care of and being good to one's parents, and exhibiting love, respect, support, reverence and loyalty to them.

In the Judeo-Christian tradition the respect for the elderly is especially stressed in the fourth commandment: honor your father and mother, which is "addressed expressly to children in their relationship to their father and mother, because this relationship is the most universal. It likewise concerns *the ties of kinship between members of the extended family. It requires honor, affection, and gratitude toward elders and ancestors*". (CCC 2199).

The Elderly have suffered much during this pandemic. They, along with children, have been the most impacted psychologically and physically with this pandemic since they had to remain indoors deprived of any religious or social activities in person. That said, when we opened up the churches again, they were the first to come back to Mass because they live, treasure, and know the importance of receiving the Eucharist and living the faith in community. I pray that with the help and support of all of us they may continue to be present in the daily and Sunday Masses.

Let us honor and celebrate our grandparents and elderly in the community of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. There are many concrete ways in which we can show them that we love them and are grateful for what they do for each one of us.

Plenary Indulgence


On May 13, the Apostolic Penitentiary promulgated a Decree granting a Plenary Indulgence on the occasion of the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. (July 26, 2021)

- The elderly can obtain an Indulgence by participating in one of the Masses celebrated on the occasion of this World Day.
- In view of the continuing health emergency and the fact that some elderly people are unable to attend Mass in person for health reasons, the Indulgence is extended to those who participate via television, radio or the internet.
- The Indulgence is also granted to all those who perform a 'work of mercy' on this World Day by visiting an elderly person who is alone.
- In places where visiting in person is expressly forbidden by the public authorities in order to avoid contagion, it is also possible to obtain the Indulgence through a virtual meeting

¡Saludos en el Señor!

El 26 de julio celebramos el memorial de los santos Joaquín y Ana, abuelos de Jesús. En toda la Iglesia celebramos Jornada Mundial de los Abuelos y las Personas Mayores para recordarle a las personas la gran bendición que nuestros abuelos son para nuestras familias y para la sociedad.

Uno solo puede imaginar el papel que jugaron los santos Joaquín y Ana en la vida de Jesús. Lo más probable es que Joaquín y Ana ayudaron a María y José con la crianza, educación y formación en la fe de Jesús.



Hemos recorrido un largo camino desde la época de Jesús, pero algunas cosas siguen igual. Los abuelos de hoy continúan ayudando a sus hijos e hijas a criar a sus hijos. De hecho, hay muchos abuelos que llevan a sus nietos a la escuela, al deporte, a las actividades artísticas, les cuidan, les cocinan y lo más importante les transmiten la Fe Católica.

Muchas culturas orientales dan prioridad a la unidad familiar y valoran a la persona mayor con el mayor respeto. Basan esta práctica en la piedad filial confuciana, que exige cuidar y ser bueno con los padres, y mostrarles amor, respeto, apoyo, reverencia y lealtad.

En la tradición judeocristiana el respeto por las personas de mayor edad se acentúa especialmente en el cuarto mandamiento: honra a tu padre y a tu madre, que “se dirige expresamente a los hijos en su relación con su padre y su madre, porque esta relación es la más universal. También se refiere a los lazos de parentesco entre miembros de la familia extendida. Requiere honor, afecto y gratitud hacia los ancianos y los antepasados ”(CCC 2199).

Las personas mayores han sufrido mucho durante esta pandemia. Ellos, junto con los niños, han sido los más afectados psicológica y físicamente con esta pandemia, ya que tuvieron que permanecer aislados de cualquier actividad religiosa o social. Dicho esto, cuando abrimos las iglesias nuevamente, fueron los primeros en regresar a la Misa porque viven, atesoran y conocen la importancia de recibir la Eucaristía y vivir la fe en comunidad. Rezo para que con la ayuda y el apoyo de todos nosotros puedan seguir estando presentes en las misas diarias y dominicales.

Honremos y celebremos a nuestros abuelos y a las personas mayores en la comunidad de la Iglesia Católica Blessed Trinity. Hay muchas formas concretas en las que podemos demostrarles que los amamos y estamos agradecidos por lo que hacen por cada uno de nosotros.

Indulgencia Plenaria

- En vista de la continua emergencia sanitaria y de que algunas personas mayores no pueden asistir a la misa en persona por motivos de salud, la indulgencia se extiende a quienes participan a través de la televisión, la radio o la web.
- La indulgencia se concede también a todos aquellos que, con ocasión de la Jornada, realizan una obra de misericordia visitando a una persona mayor sola.
- En los lugares en los que, para evitar el contagio, la visita en persona está expresamente prohibida por las autoridades públicas, también es posible obtener la Indulgencia a través de un encuentro virtual.


