Standards-Based Learning and Assessment

ICS uses a standards-based approach for reporting student learning in the high school. In each course, teachers cover a variety of standards and rate student performance against grade-level standards based on the following scale: **Exemplary, Meeting, Approaching, Support Needed, and No Progress**

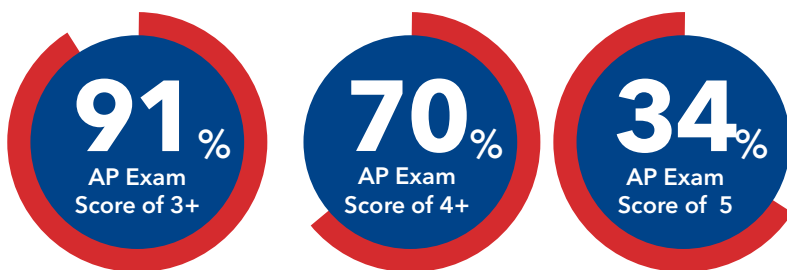
Students are required to take 0.5 credit of Bible for each year enrolled at ICS. Beginning in 2020-2021, for each year a student is enrolled at ICS, he/she is required to take 0.25 credit of Week Without Walls.

How do we calculate GPA?

Only classes taken at ICS or through NorthStar Academy are calculated in a student's GPA. Students receive an extra 0.5 point for honors courses and an extra 1.0 point for AP courses added to their GPA. ICS does not rank students.

Advanced Placement & SAT/ACT Performance

In 2020, 46 ICS students took 80 AP exams. Students take AP courses either at ICS or online through Northstar Academy.

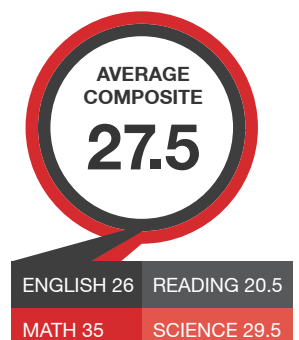
