



# NHCS - Personal Network

## Windows 10 Instructions

1. Click on the **network icon** in the taskbar. This is located on the bottom right corner of your screen and in most cases looks like a globe. We have highlighted the icon in yellow.




2. Make sure the **Wi-Fi** for your device is turned on. This will give you a short list of networks. Select the **NHCS-Personal** network.





3. Check the box to **Connect automatically** and click **Connect**.




4. Click **Connect** to proceed.

5. Enter your **standard NHCS user credentials**. For example, it should be the same username and password that you use to log into a school desktop.



6. If it says, **“Connected, secured”** under the NHCS-Personal label, and you see that the network icon has changed to a **“wireless connected” icon**, then you are now connected to the personal device network and should be able to browse the internet.
