



Uniform Guide and School Shop Information

The Millfield School Shop is located by turning left as you enter the school gates, opposite the north car park.

It offers a full and complete personal fitting out service for new and existing students. For new starters, appointments are available throughout the summer until the start of term. It is advisable to pre-book your appointment as early as possible; the shop gets very busy during peak times. When fitting a child, we allow for growth but are happy to exchange items assuming it has not been named and is returned in the same condition it was purchased.

The shop operates personal accounts for all students during term time. Students may purchase items from the shop, add them to their account, or pay for them separately. All items purchased on accounts must have a signed "chit" from the student's housemaster/mistress or guardian.

Sixth formers may write their own chits to a limit of £40.00 per day. Any arrangements regarding expenditure limits for the Sixth formers, should therefore be made directly with your child.

The shop offers a comprehensive range of products for all boarding and day students. In addition to Millfield uniform and games kit, the shop stocks various types of equipment, leisurewear, footwear, toiletries, a large range of stationary items, greeting cards and gifts.

Items purchased online can either be collected from the shop or sent to your home.

Name Tapes

Name tapes can be ordered from the School Shop in quantities of **144 or 72** (spares are always useful); please allow up to one week for delivery.

All items brought to school must be marked with woven name tapes which can be purchased through the school shop. The school shop will require the pupil's forename and surname to create the name tapes, please confirm with the shop when making your appointment.

Items which cannot be sewn should be marked with a permanent black or metallic felt tip e.g. contents of wash bag.

Uniform Guidance Year 9, 10 and 11

- *Students wear either Option A or Option B uniform. No mix and match between options allowed.*
- *Formal uniform is worn for school functions and formal occasions, i.e. Headmaster's Assembly, Wells Cathedral Service and away matches etc.*

Option A

Everyday Uniform

School regulation navy school suit jacket and trousers, blue striped shirt or plain white shirt, Millfield crested navy V neck sweater, school or house tie. Shoes should be plain, smart, flat, black polishable, no suede or canvas, boots or trainer style (e.g. Nike Air Force 1). Coats to be plain, dark colour, the hem to reach below suit jacket length. No gilets and no embellishments e.g. fur trim, beading etc.

Formal Uniform

School regulation navy school suit jacket and trousers, plain white shirt, Millfield crested navy V neck jumper, school or house tie, navy/grey/black socks. Shoes should be plain, smart, flat, black polishable, no suede or canvas, boots or trainer style (e.g. Nike Air Force 1).

Sports Clothes

Reversible sports jersey, tracksuit top, tracksuit bottoms, PE shorts, trainers, white sport socks, games socks, waterproof jacket, towel as well as any personal equipment required for various sports e.g. mouth guard, hockey stick, tennis racket, cricket bat.

Option B

Everyday Uniform

School regulation navy striped suit jacket with either skirt or trouser option, pale blue and white striped blouse or plain white blouse (no tie), Millfield crested navy V neck jumper, navy/grey/black socks or tights, white ankle socks if with skirt in summer only. Shoes should be plain, smart, flat, black polishable, no suede or canvas, boots or trainer style (e.g. Nike Air Force 1). Coats to be plain, dark colour, the hem to reach below suit jacket length. No gilets or embellishments e.g. fur trim, beading.

Formal Uniform

School regulation navy striped suit jacket with either skirt or trouser option, plain white blouse (no tie), Millfield crested navy V neck jumper, navy/grey/black socks or tights, white ankle socks if with skirt in summer only. Shoes should be plain, smart, flat, black polishable, no suede or canvas, boots or trainer style (e.g. Nike Air Force 1).

Sports Clothes

Reversible sports jersey, tracksuit top, tracksuit bottoms, skirt, PE shorts, trainers, white sports socks, games socks, waterproof jacket, towel as well as any personal equipment required for various sports e.g. mouth guard, hockey stick, tennis racket, cricket bat.

Personal appearance:

- Very minimal make up is permitted, no lipstick or nail varnish allowed.
- Clean shaven appearance at all times. Hair must be smart and not impair vision, if dyed should be a natural hair colour only.
- Any jewellery should be simple and discreet, no highly conspicuous earrings e.g. large hoops, no visible ankle bracelets and no face or body piercings or tattoos allowed.

Uniform Guidance Sixth Form (Year 12 and 13)

- Sixth Form Option A and Option B uniform does not need to be purchased at the school shop (except for school ties and sports clothes).
- Students wear either Option A or Option B uniform. No mix and match between options allowed.
- Formal uniform includes white shirt or blouse and is worn for school functions, formal occasions, i.e. Headmaster Assembly, Wells Cathedral Service and away matches etc

Option A

Trouser suit (black, dark grey or dark blue; faint pin stripe or very subtle check permitted), optional waistcoat plain or to match suit. No leather or shiny fabric. Trousers must be straight legged (not skin-tight), full length and with a visible vertical crease.

A formal full-length sleeved shirt, with conventional collar, cuffs and fabric, in a plain, checked, or striped style worn tucked in. School tie purchased from the school shop.

Option B

Trouser or skirt suit (black, dark grey or dark blue; faint pin stripe or very subtle check permitted). No leather or shiny fabric. Trousers must be straight legged (not skin-tight or legging style), full length with a visible vertical crease. Skirt hemlines must fall between knee and mid-calf. A split at the back of the skirt is permitted but must be of no more than 5cm. Optional waistcoat – plain or to match suit. A formal full sleeved blouse of conventional collar and fabric in a plain, checked, or striped style worn tucked in. No beading, lace, or other embellishments. Ties are not to be worn with a blouse.

Items that can be worn with Options A and B

A plain, dark coloured, V or round neck jumper i.e. black, grey, navy blue, bottle green.

No cardigans, half zip jumpers or sweatshirts allowed.

Jumpers must be suitable for wearing under a suit jacket, the bottom of the jumper must not hang below the jacket length.

Dark blue, black, grey or flesh coloured tights.

Plain socks with trouser suit.

Shoes should be plain, smart, flat black or brown polishable shoes. No suede or canvas, boots or trainer style (e.g. Nike Air Force 1).

Coats to be plain, dark colour, the hem to reach below suit jacket length. No gilets and no embellishments e.g. fur trim, beading etc.

Sixth Form Sports Clothes

Sixth Formers require core items of the Millfield sports kit (tracksuit, shorts and top) which will need to be purchased from the school shop. Sport specific kit may be purchased depending upon individual specialism.

Personal appearance:

- Jewellery: no more than two necklaces, two bracelets, two rings and two earrings (in each ear) to be worn at once, no highly conspicuous earrings e.g. large hoops. No other piercings or any tattoos allowed. No visible ankle bracelets.
- Hair must be neat and tidy and not impair vision. Hair, if dyed, should be of a natural hair colour only.
- Minimal makeup is permitted; no lipstick or nail varnish allowed. Clean shaven appearance at all times.

Clothing Check List for Year 9, 10 and 11

- All items marked * must be purchased from the school shop.
- Quantities are based on boarding students; shop staff will advise day parents.
