

## Texas A&M Commerce Scholarship Opportunities

Kaufman High School is excited to announce that we will be working in conjunction with Texas A&M Commerce this year to provide scholarship opportunities for our students and employees. Please see the information below outlining the details of each scholarship opportunity.

### **President's Promise Scholarship -**

- Qualifications:
  - Filed FAFSA
  - Pell Grant eligible
  - Household Adjusted Gross Income of \$50,000 or less
- Award:
  - Full remaining tuition after Pell Grants applied
- Duration:
  - Up to 8 long semesters or graduation (whichever comes first)
- Renewal Requirements:
  - Maintain a minimum 2.00 semester and institutional cumulative GPA
  - Successfully enroll and complete a minimum of 15 A&M-Commerce credit hours each Fall/Spring semester and 30 A&M-Commerce credit hours each academic year

### **Blue & Gold Freshman Scholarships -**

- Tier 1 - \$2,000
  - Qualifications - around 3.8 GPA & class rank near top 20%
  - Duration - up to 8 long semesters or graduation (whichever comes first) Four year valued at \$8,000
- Tier 2 - \$1,000
  - Qualifications - around 3.5 GPA & class rank near top 30%
  - Duration - up to 8 long semesters or graduation (whichever comes first) Four year valued at \$4,000
- Tier 3 - \$500
  - Qualifications - around 3.0 GPA & class rank near top 50%
  - Duration - up to 8 long semesters or graduation (whichever comes first) Four year valued at \$2,000
- Renewal Requirements:
  - Maintain a minimum 2.75 semester and institutional cumulative GPA
  - Successfully enroll and complete a minimum of 15 A&M-Commerce credit hours each Fall/Spring semester and 30 A&M-Commerce credit hours each academic year

### **Quick Start Grant -**

- KISD staff will be eligible for the Quick Start Grant which gives \$500/semester for graduates enrolled in at least 6 hours per semester at TAMU-Commerce.

### **Teacher Of The Year Award -**

- The teacher of the year at Kaufman High School for the 2021-2022 school year will receive \$750/semester in recognition of their outstanding performance.
