Students who complete the program will receive a “Law Cohort” designation on their transcripts.

*Semester courses; **AP English Language and Composition (taken junior or senior year) provides the best preparation for legal writing; however, if a student is not qualified to take the course, an alternate Honors English course will suffice. ***AP U.S. Government & Politics closely matches Law Cohort objectives; however, if a student is not qualified to take the course, a college preparatory Government course will suffice.

Additionally, at some point during high school, students must participate in one or more of the following competitive Academic Teams:

- Mock Trial
- Model United Nations
- Speech & Debate

Students may receive a waiver of this requirement from the Vice Principal of Academics if an irreconcilable schedule conflict exists and they complete an alternate skill-development activity.

REQUIREMENTS

- New Applicants: Submit Application by July 1
- GPA of 3.00 or higher
- Complete 125 hours of internship by graduation
- Attend field trips and conferences
- Participate in evening lectures/activities
- Annual fee of \$500
