CHES (FROM 5 YEARS OLD)

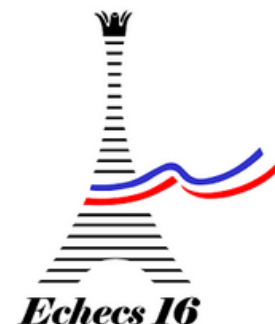
(with Club chess 16)

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Capoeira (from CP) (with International Capoeira School France)



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Capoeira is an Afro-Brazilian art form that combines elements of dance, music, acrobatics and martial arts created in Brazil in the 16th century. It is known for its fast and complex movements, primarily using power, speed and leverage for leg movements.

Today, Capoeira is expressed more like a game than a fight. It's a dance, it's a sport ... It indeed combines physical activity (an exceptional system of self-defense and cardiovascular exercises) and music.

The basic movements of Capoeira are adapted and taught to children through games. Our convincing method is to appeal to the imagination; it helps to capture children's attention and concentration. Our efficient method is the body representation of the imaginary, with the predominant fantasy. It establishes a connection with the real world, through psychomotor activities, which links the child to reality.

Among various cultural and historical aspects, we base our method on three main pillars: naturalness, creativity and cooperativity.

The presence of music, history and dance within capoeira are also strong aspects that make this sport an excellent tool to help in the education of the child.
