## Professional Learning (PL) and Support for Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs) in Florida Working with Students who are Deaf/Hard of Hearing (DHH)

The Bureau of Exceptional Education and Student Services (BEESS) collaborates across agencies to coordinate programs that support students with disabilities throughout Florida. BEESS oversees <a href="IDEA-funded state projects">IDEA-funded state projects</a> that offer professional learning, technical assistance, resources, and guidance to school districts and families—ensuring every student in Florida has the opportunity to reach their full potential.



The Resource Materials and Technology Center for the Deaf/Hard of Hearing (RMTC-DHH) works collaboratively with all Florida stakeholders to positively influence outcomes of students who are deaf or hard of hearing (DHH) in preparation for college, career, and life. RMTC-DHH supports families and school personnel by researching current national and state initiatives, by procuring interventions, curricula, and assessments, and by utilizing data to assist stakeholders in implementing instructional practices (section 1003.55, Florida Statutes). RMTC-DHH staff members provide training, technical assistance, and resources to school districts, agencies, associations, families, and other state and federal discretionary projects working with students who are DHH in Florida.
