TMISD is in direct contact and receiving guidance from the Nueces County Health Department regarding COVID.

As advised, until further direction or mandate is received from the Governor and/or the Texas Education Agency and out of an abundance of caution, **we are encouraging our staff and students to wear a mask while in our school facilities.** *We cannot force or require anyone to wear a mask* but we hope this effort will help protect those who are non-vaccinated and/or who may be immune-compromised.

Also, if your student is exhibiting any signs of COVID, please keep your student at home and seek the guidance of your personal physician.

TMISD will continue to -

- mitigate COVID through sanitization efforts
- provide hand sanitizer in each classroom
- encourage handwashing at all grade levels
- provide stop-and-wash moments in grades PK-2

In addition, COVID vaccines will be made available to all age-eligible students, provided by the Nueces County Health Department, at no cost. *More information coming soon.*
