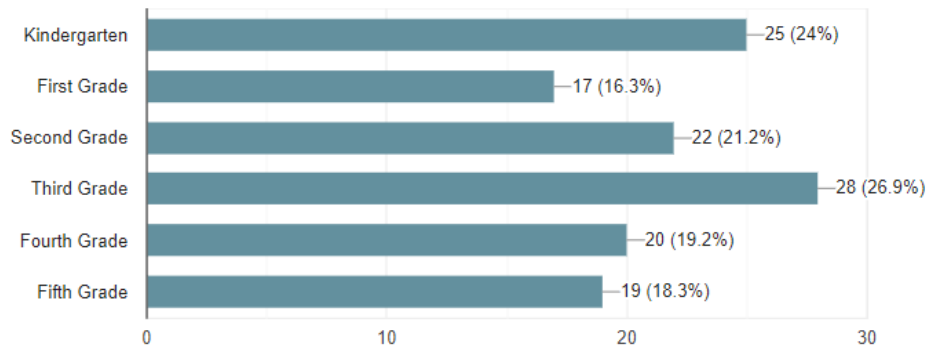


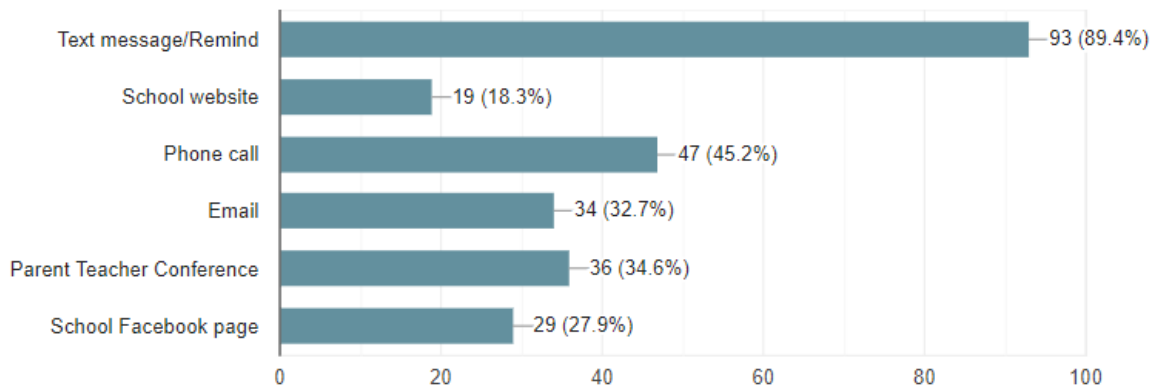
1. What grade is your child in? (If you have more than one child at TCES, check all the grades that apply.)

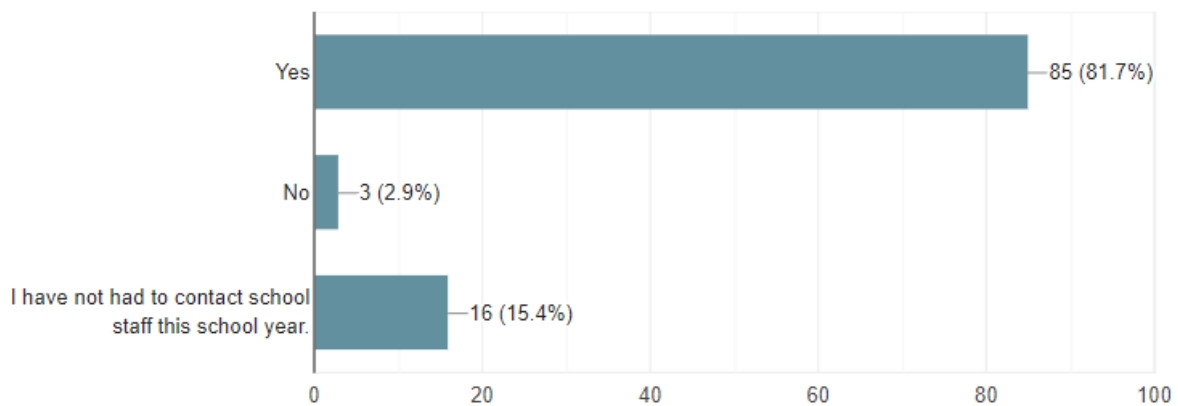
2. What types of communication do you prefer when it comes to your child's education?

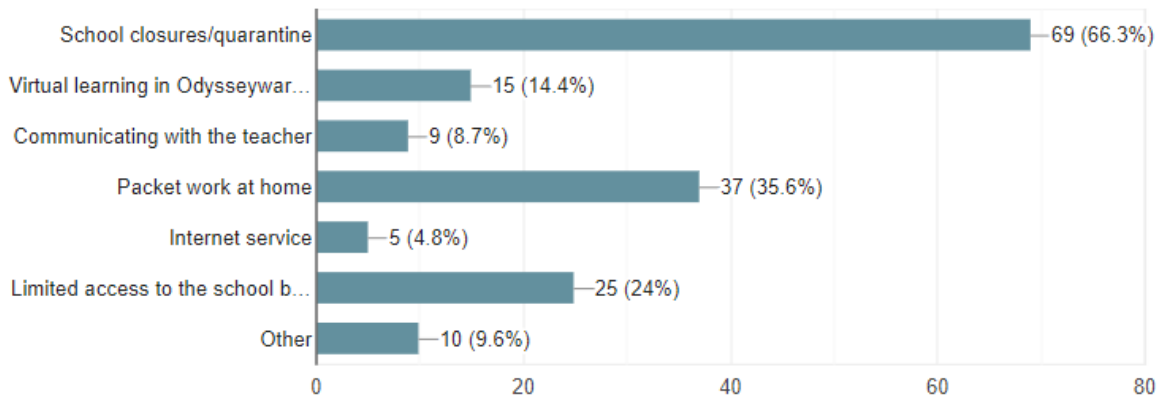
3. Was the school staff helpful and available when you've needed information this school year?

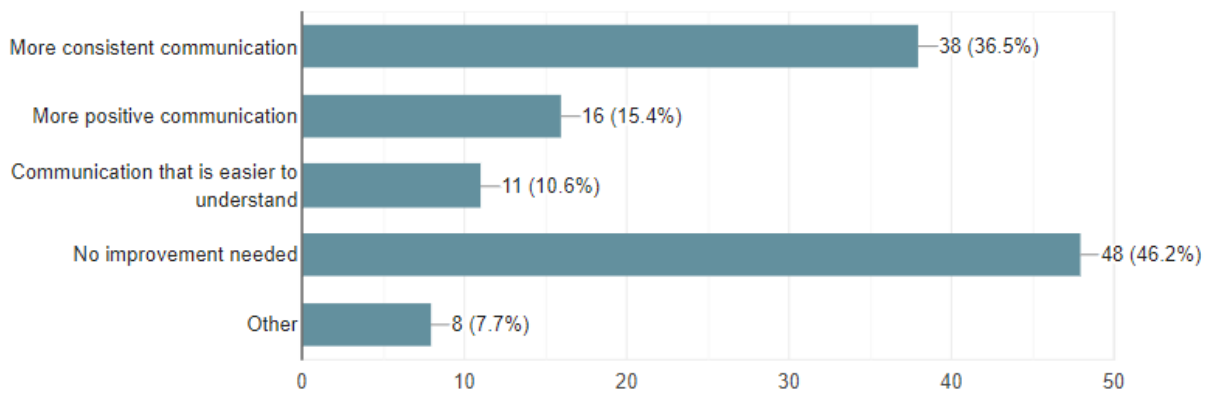
4. What has been the most difficult thing about this school year?

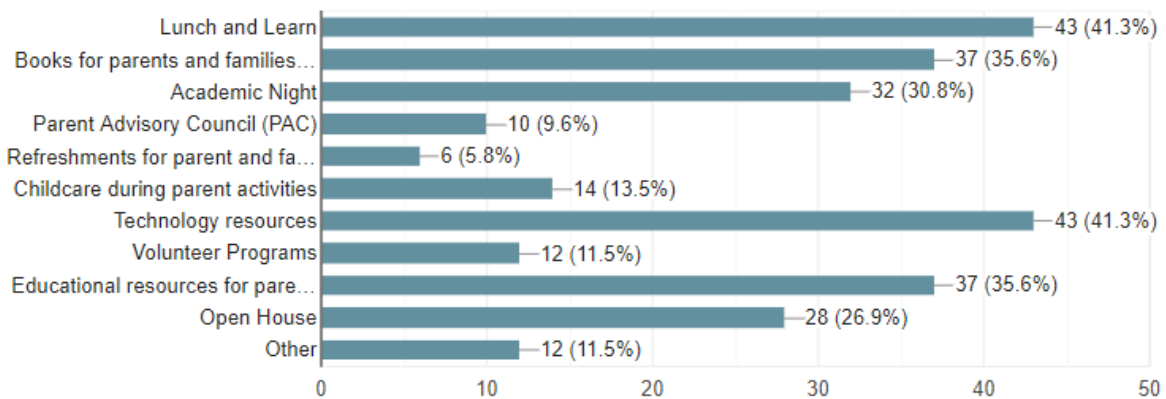
5. What ways can the school improve communication?

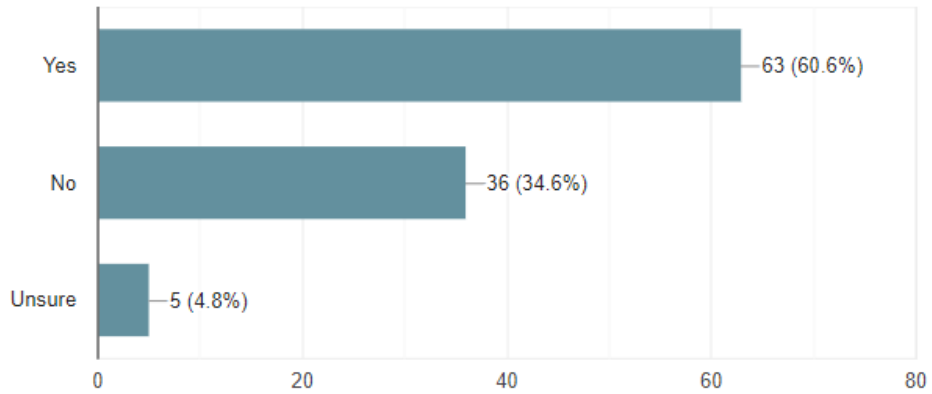
6. How would you like to see the parent engagement funds used at your child's school? (Check all that apply.)

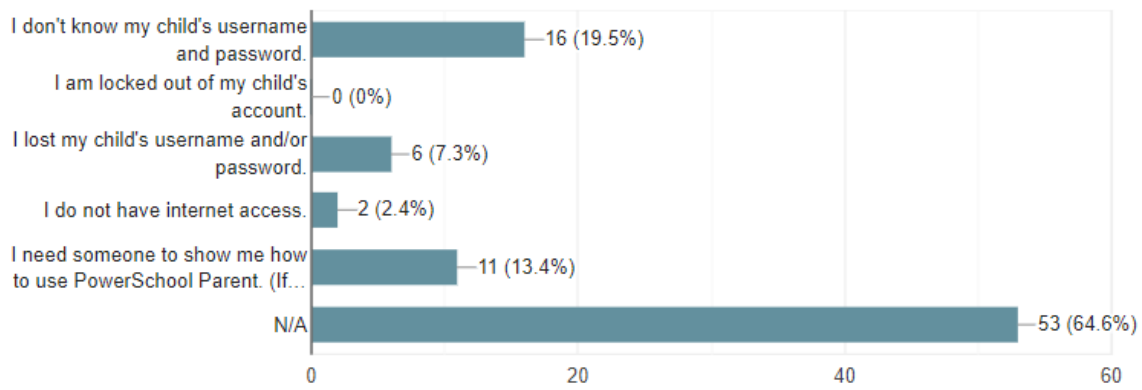
7. Have you used PowerSchool Parent to check your child's grades online this school year?

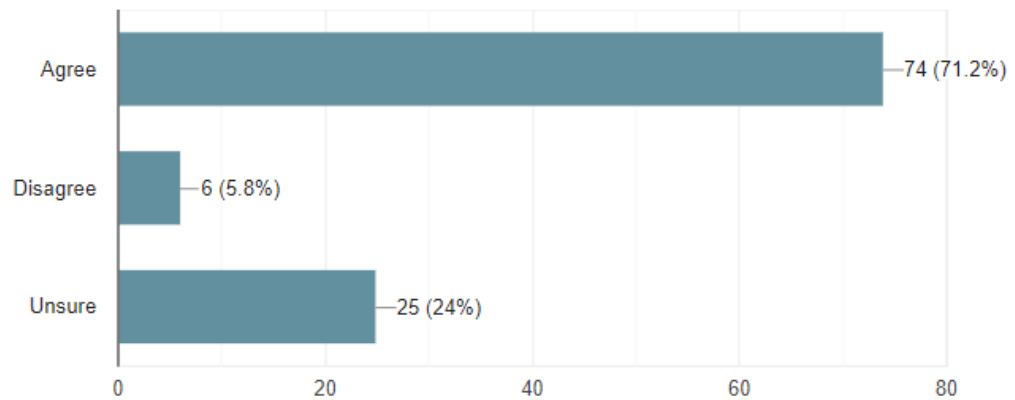

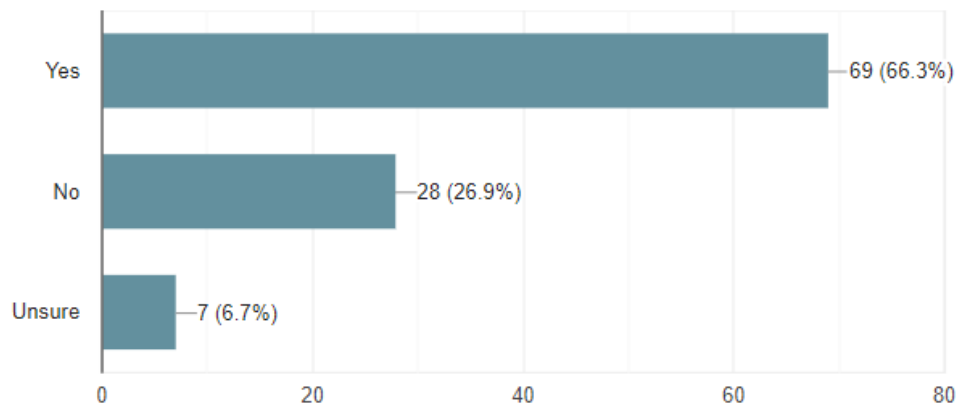

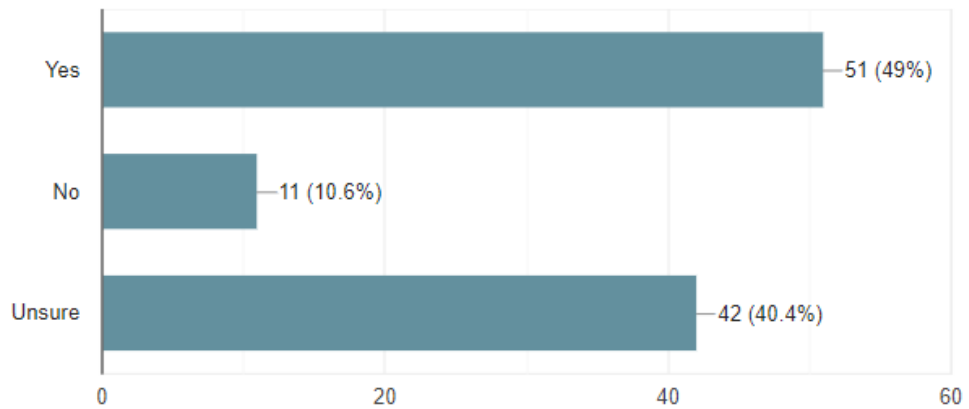
10. My child's teacher has explained my child's strengths and weaknesses to me?

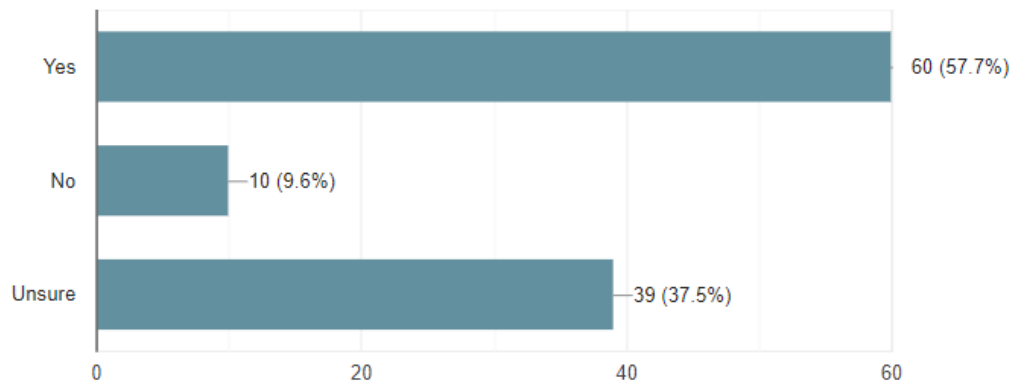
