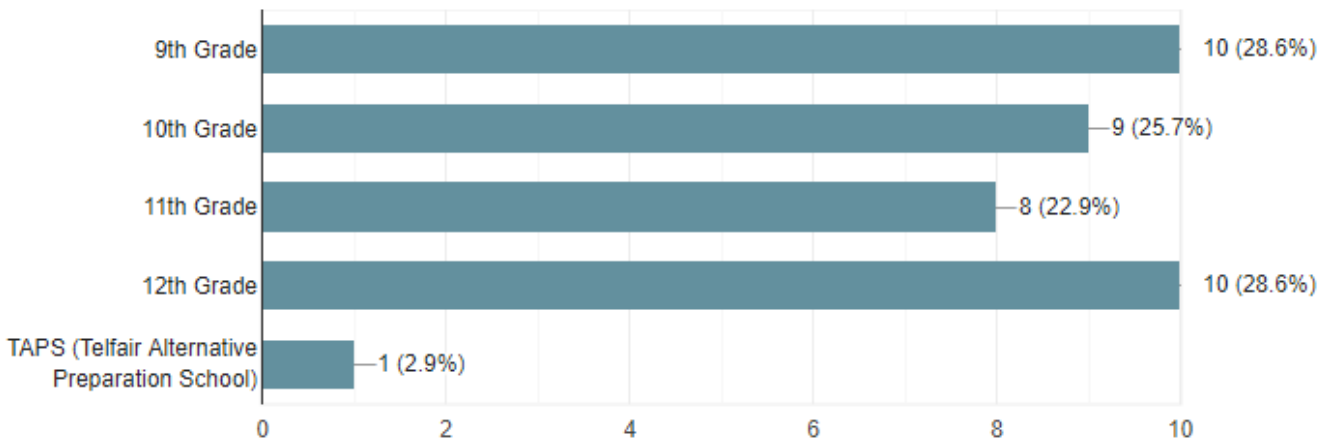


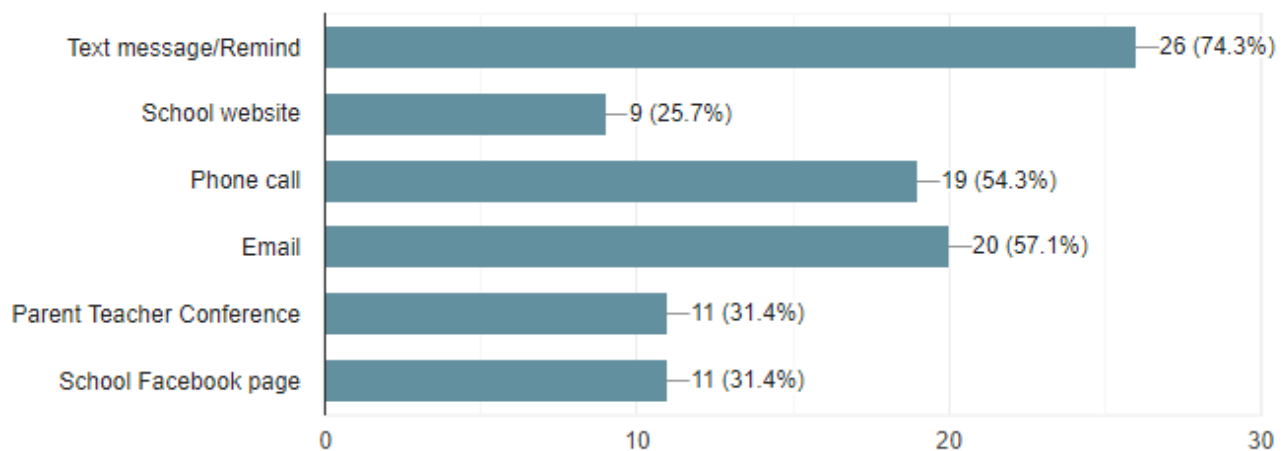
1. What grade is your child in? (If you have more than one child at TCHS, check all the grades that apply.)

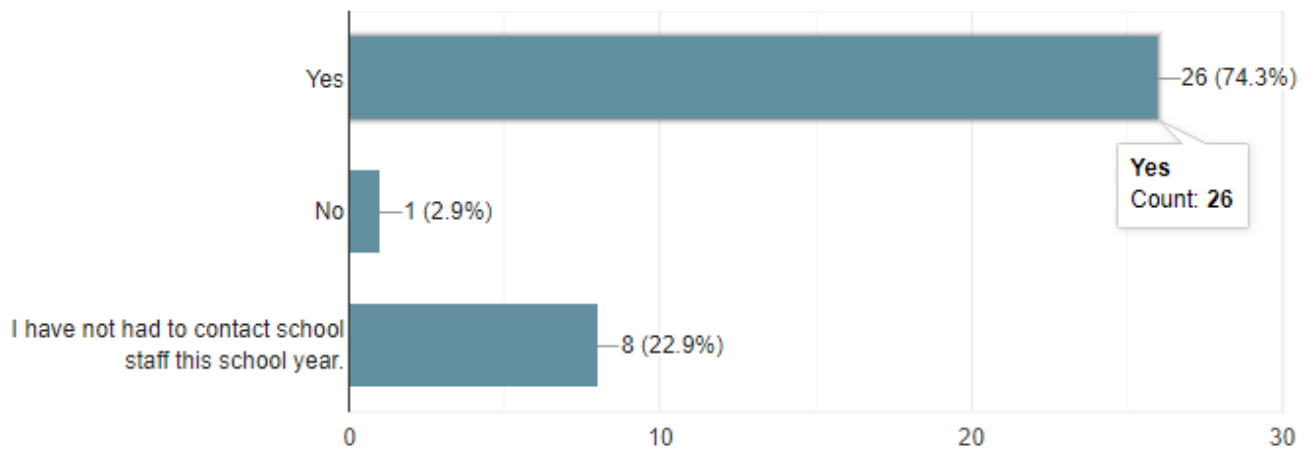
2. What types of communication do you prefer when it comes to your child's education?

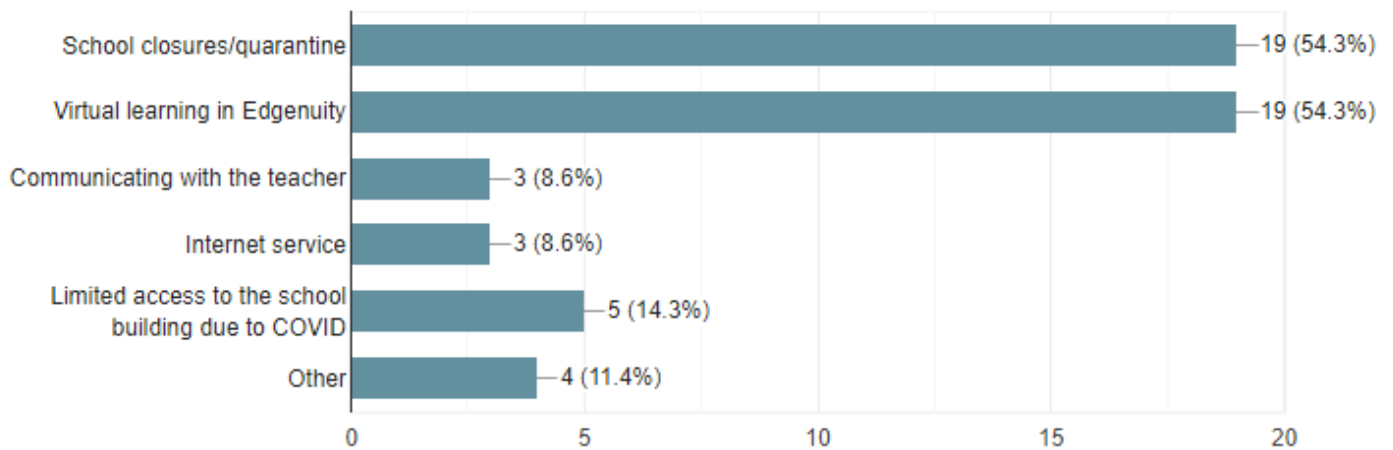
3. Was the school staff helpful and available when you've needed information this school year?

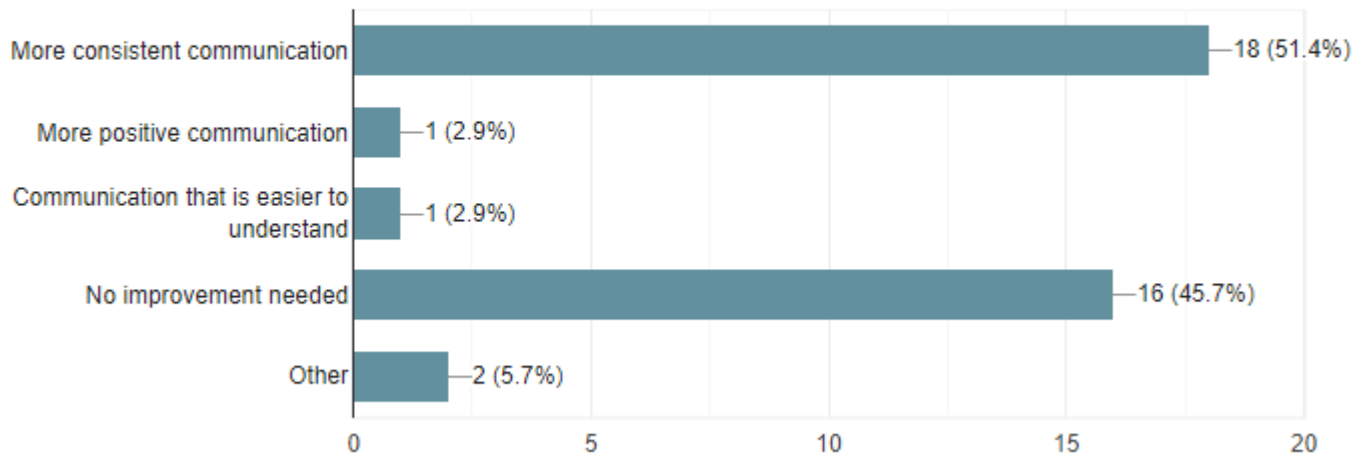
4. What has been the most difficult thing about this school year?

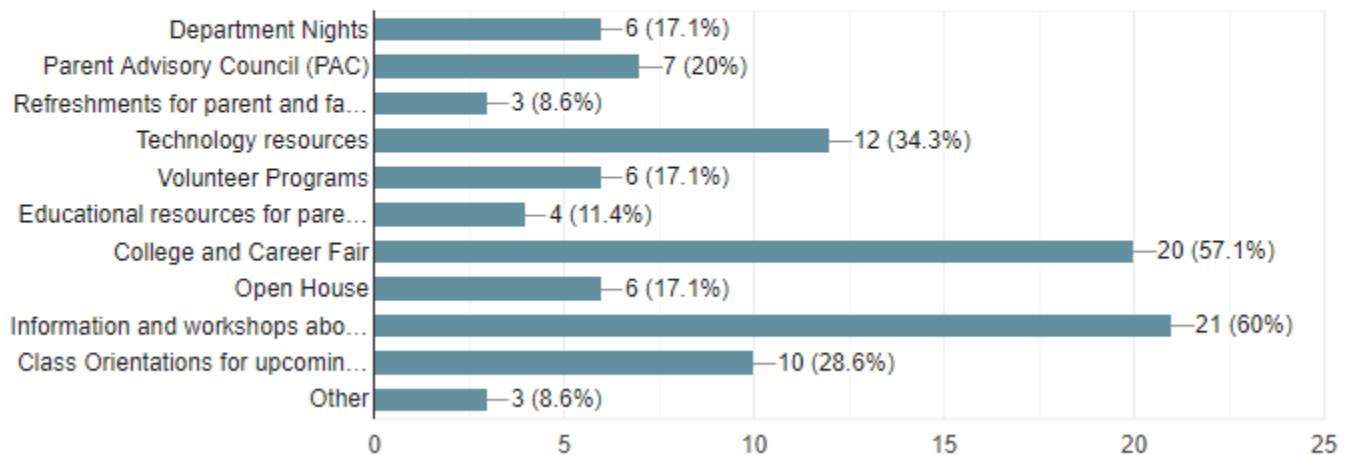

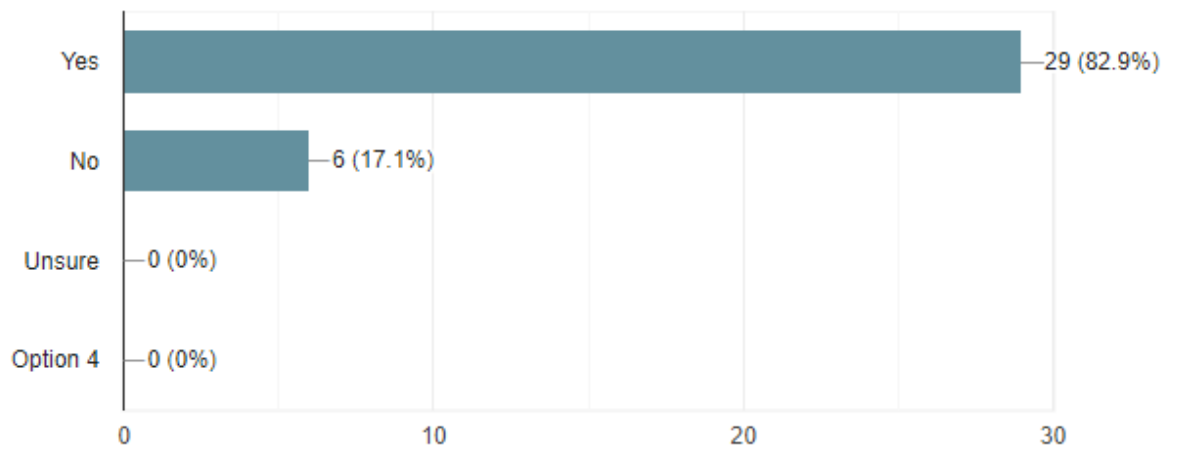

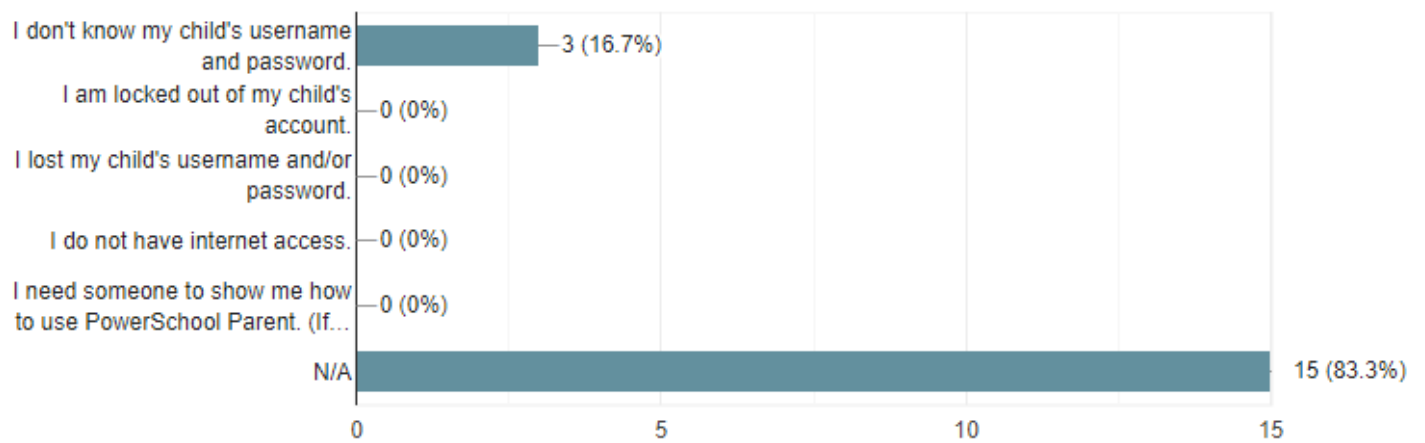

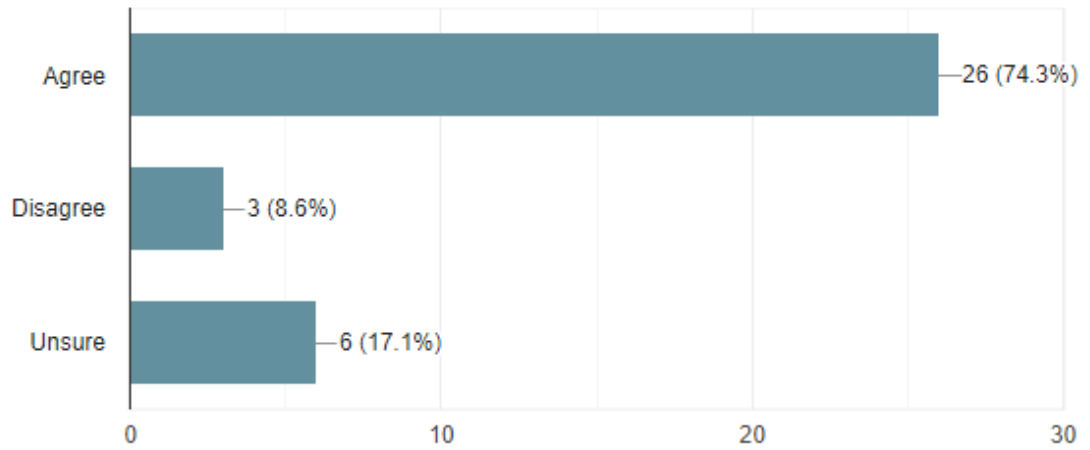

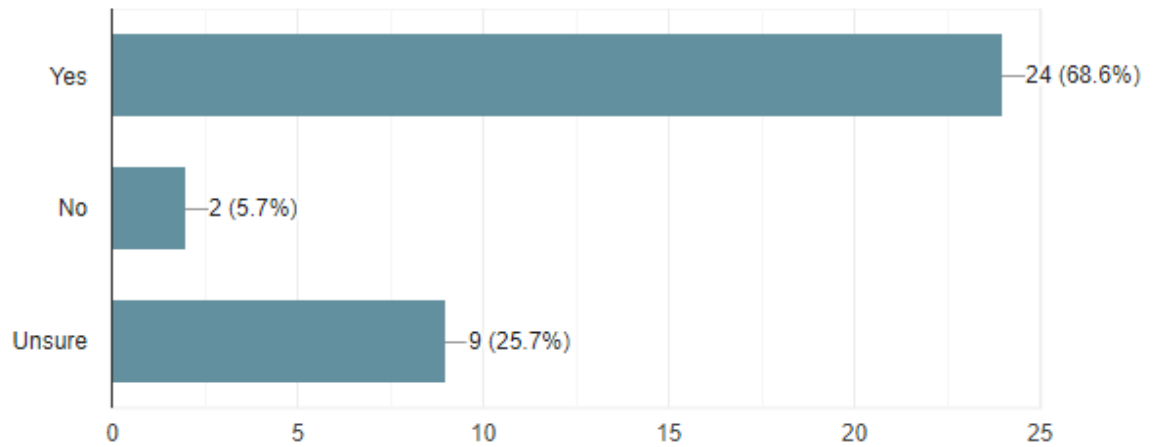
10. I understand what my child needs to complete before he/she can graduate?

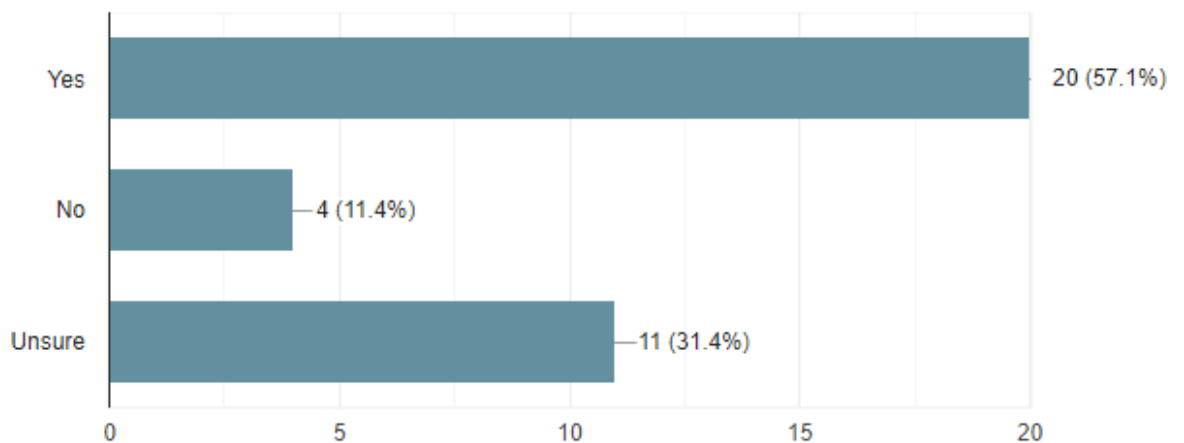

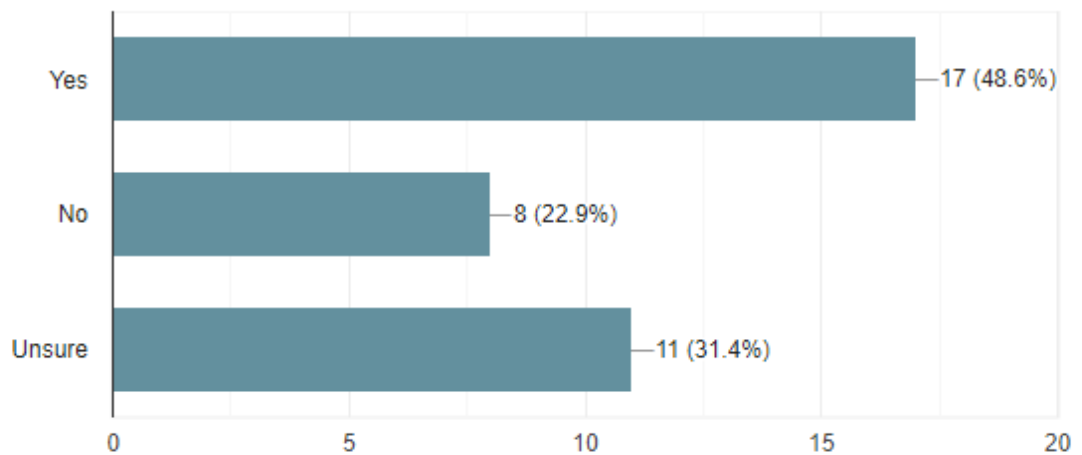
