Distribution Days

There are no distribution days or freshman orientation days for students entering Haber Oaks Campus. We will distribute materials and hold orientation type activities on our first day of in-person attendance. If you have not done so, please make sure to complete online registration in the Skyward student information system, and plan to drop off your 9th grade physical at Haber Oaks between 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. on either August 3, 4, or 5.

Free of Reduced Lunches and/or Waiver of Fees

To apply, parents must complete a financial needs application certifying their eligibility based on family income. For fee waivers, parents must bring copies of the previous four weeks income, including pay stubs for everyone in the household, child support, or filed 2020 tax form to the Student Services Office at your student's home high school to complete the paperwork. Waiver forms will be available late July. Attendance

Because irregular or poor attendance denies the student opportunities to maximize benefits from teachers and fellow students, the following policies have been adopted:

- A parent or guardian must call the school each day a student misses all or part of their school day.
- You may leave information on the automated voicemail system 24 hours a day, or you may call the switchboard between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- Written notes are not acceptable to excuse absences.
- **Failure to call the school within 24 hours of a student absence results in an unexcused absence or truancy.**

School Procedures

ID Cards

Students are required to wear their ID cards at all times while at school. The ID card is required for all attendance purposes in various cases. All students will receive their IDs the first week of school.

Student Parking

Due to limited space, only Juniors and Seniors with a permit are allowed to park in the Haber Oaks parking lot. Please contact Haber Oaks for more information.

Student Handbook

The student handbook includes all school rules and regulations on academics, student conduct, attendance, transportation, athletics, and activities.

Parents and students must become familiar with the content of the student handbook, which is available on the school's website. All students will be held accountable for the information in the handbook.

Health Information

Emergency Contact & Health Information

Emergency contact and health information may be up-dated by the parent/guardian at any time during the school year. This emergency information is important to your child's welfare in the event of an illness or injury occurring at school. Please take the time during online registration or at any time during the school year to review this information and make any necessary updates or corrections. The steps to enter or update information are:

1. Go to <https://hoc.d155.org> and click on Skyward Family Access under quick links "For Parents" on the right column of the homepage. Enter login and password credentials.
2. Under "General Information" on the left side of the screen, click "Student Information"
3. Click "Request change(s) to my child's information" located on the right side of the screen, above the alert information box.
4. Click the appropriate button (request changes to: "Information, Contacts, or Health Information") on the right side.
5. Type in any changes and click "Save."

Vaccinations

Proof of a Tdap (combined tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) is required before students may register for the 2021-2022 school year. The Td is not acceptable per Illinois Department of Public Health.

Seniors: all seniors must have proof of a Meningitis Vaccination after the age of 16 years. They will not be able to complete the registration process without this documentation. This documentation may be submitted to the main office during posted summer hours.

Medical Forms

If your student requires medication at school, the enclosed medication authorization form (last page) must be on file at Haber Oaks. You also may download this form on our website under "Important Forms and Documents." You must fill out this form each year, and it must be signed by both a parent/guardian and physician. This form is required for **both prescription and over-the-counter medications**, including Tylenol, Aspirin, Midol, antacids, etc. as well as asthma inhalers and Epi-pens. Students may carry inhalers and Epi-pens with them during school.

Freshman Information

Freshman Physicals & Immunizations

The Illinois Department of Human Services requires that all 9th grade students must have a physical examination by a licensed physician or nurse practitioner within one year prior to entry into high school. The physical and immunizations must be documented on the revised Illinois Department of Human Services form which was enclosed in the 8th grade packet distributed in January. Physicals recorded on the IHSA Athletic Physical form are not accepted by the Illinois Department of Human Services for entry into high school. You may download the DHS physical form by accessing the forms link at <https://hoc.d155.org/>.

The student must also have received the minimum immunization requirements. Proof of the Tdap (combined tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) is required before students may register for the 2021-22 school year. Illinois state law also requires a Td booster every 10 years as a minimum immunization requirement. Please submit written proof of a current Td booster to Haber Oaks Campus prior to the first day of school.

Incoming Freshman will not be allowed to complete registration without a current physical and compliant immunizations.

Senior Information

Meningitis immunization

Every high school Senior will be required to show proof of having a Meningitis Vaccination after the age of 16 years. These can be submitted to the main office prior to the first day of school. Seniors will not be able to complete the registration process without this documentation.
