


Community & Diocesan Updates

NEW GUIDELINES FOR POSTAGE STAMP DONATIONS – Due to a change in how outreach projects/collections are now being conducted at the parish, <u>used and new stamps and other philatelic items are no longer being accepted at the parish</u> <u>Office nor at the Welcome Desk</u>. You can send your canceled stamps and other postal items directly to the Sisters of Notre Dame, Stamp Ministry, 100 Augusta Hall-Saint Mary's, Notre Dame, IN 46556. They're especially interested in receiving stamp albums. To keep things simple, collect only commemorative and high value and foreign stamps, NOT the American flag, "USA", an eagle, fruit or stars as they have no resale value. Philatelic items such as first day covers, stamp dedication programs, mint stamp blocks and sheets are highly desirable. The Sisters' Stamp Ministry uses the funds generated from the sale of these postal items to fund their missionary work around the world. Thank you!

NEW TRIP – Vienna Parks & Recreation invites you to join other adults on a trip to Somerset County, PA, to view the Flight 93 National Memorial on September 9, 7:30 am-4:30 pm. This trip promises to be a very special one, as it commemorates the crash of United Airlines Flight 93, which was one of the aircraft hijacked in the September 11 attacks. You'll first stop at the Visitor Center that features a permanent exhibition focusing on the Flight 93 story, the Tower of Voices, near the entrance of the park, meant to set the tone for the Memorial, and the Memorial Plaza, the final resting place of the passengers and crew members. A visit here culminates at the Wall of Names, which features forty white polished marble stones inscribed with the names of the passengers and crew. Lunch will be on your own at Liberty Café. The trip fee is \$65 for Vienna town residents, \$81.25 for everyone else. Register at <u>viennava.gov</u> beginning August 9.
