School Description

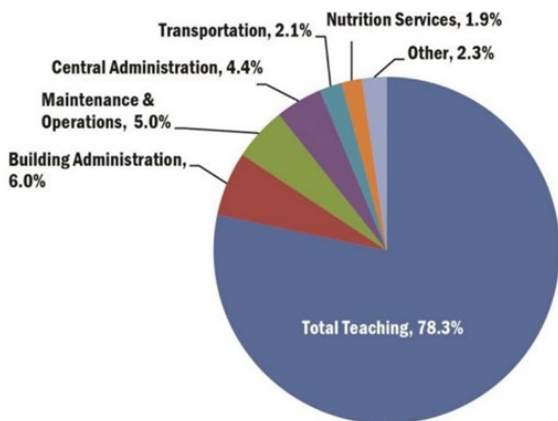

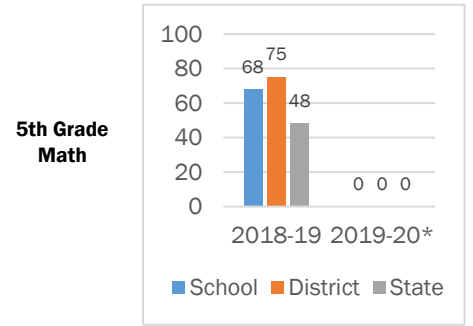
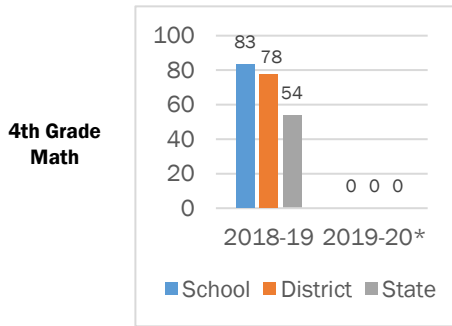
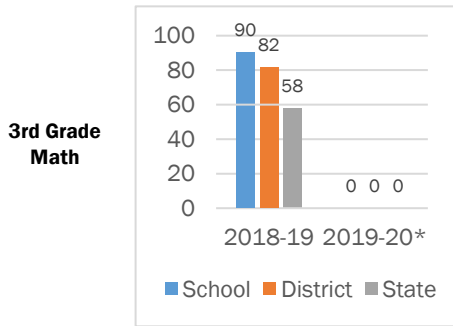
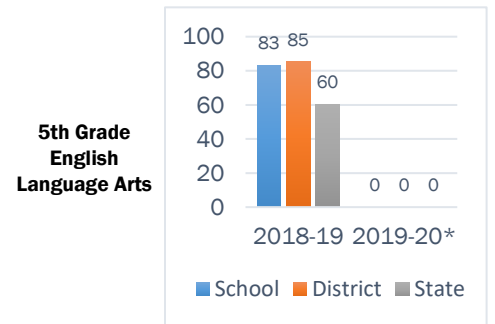
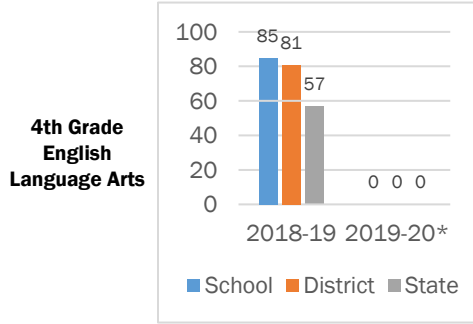
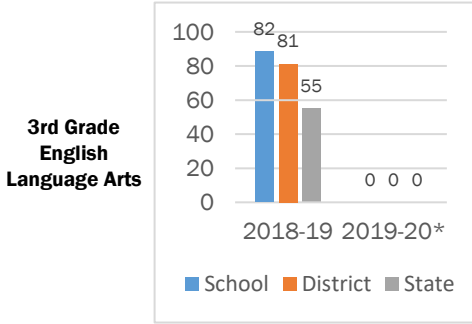
2019 20 School Goals

Teachers examined assessment results to determine school goals. They met with their colleagues to discuss strategies to increase performance in academic areas.

- Grades K-2: 85% of students at standard on end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 85% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 80% at standard
- Grade 5 science: 75% at standard
- Achievement gap: 75% of our "emerging/newcomer" ELL students will advance to "progressing as measured by 2019 ELPA score"
- School Effectiveness: Increase from 77% to 87% "agree mostly" and "agree completely" in the area of "The staff works in teams across grade levels to help increase student learning"
- Attendance: Student tardies will decrease at Mann Elementary from an average of 7.14 to 5.7 tardies per day
- Discipline: Reduce the number of discipline referrals at recess from 47 to 38 per year

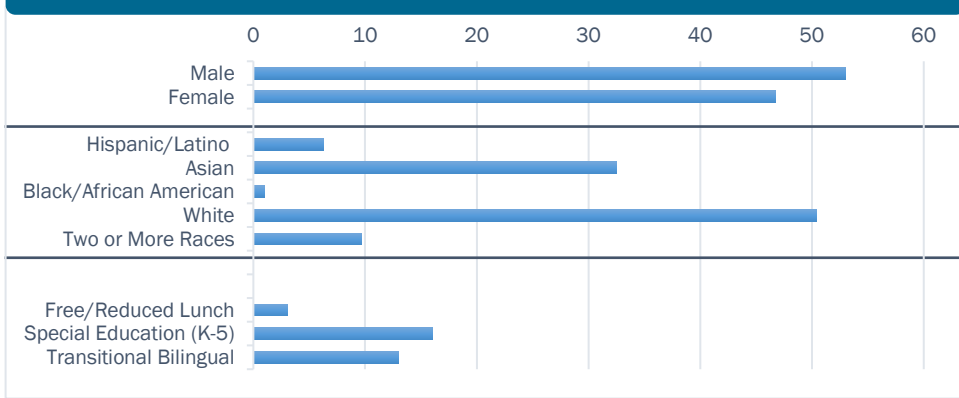
State Assessment Results
