#### **GRADUAL SEPARATING CLASSES**

#### SEPARATING CLASSES

Parents and children have time together and apart for learning. Some classes are topic bases and others are age specific. Sibling care is available for children that are under Pre-K but not the target age.

# ECFE Fall Classes

If space is available, families are welcome to join at a prorated cost. Sliding fee available.

## **MULTI AGE**

For children ages 0-5. Play and explore with your child while interacting with a small group of friends in a clean, safe, and welcoming classroom. Everyone joins together in the early childhood room for the first part of class. After circle time, parents separate to learn and share about parenting.

AM: 12 sessions, \$72. Class does not meet on November 1, 2021. PM: 12 sessions, \$60. Class does not meet on November 1, 2021.

## **CRECIENDO JUNTOS**

# ON MY OWN

For children ages 3-4. A child only class that will provide a preschool experience for your young one. Once a week your child will build on social, academic, and other skills aligned with Minnesota's Early Indicators of Progress. Children will learn through play and have fun meeting new friends. Cost is per child.

11 sessions, \$88. Class does not meet on October 20 and November 24, 2021.

# **BABY & ME**

Babies ages 2-11 months. Gather with your baby, parents and the Parent Educator for hands-on exploration that enhances a child's development. Discussions for parents will include sleep, nutrition, child development, and other common situations that occur in year one. Sibling care available.

**Mondays: 12 sessions, \$48.** Class does not meet on November 1, 2021. **Thursdays: 11 sessions, \$44.** Class does not meet on October 21 and November 25, 2021.

# TINY TOTS

For children ages 12 to 24 months. Singing, playing and block building are fun! This is a playtime centered around our smallest learners. Parents stay in the classroom and have an informal discussion during the last part of class. Sibling care available.

12 sessions, \$48. Class does not meet on November 1, 2021.

## **STEAM**

For children ages 2.5-5. Designed to keep your child thinking and actively participating in handson activities. The focus will be centered around the S.T.E.A.M principles; science, technology, engineering, arts and math. Parent discussion the last part of each class in the parent ed room

# **PARENTS CONNECTIONS**

**Baby Stop meets regularly every Thursday throughout the year. No Fee.** Occasionally, class does not meet due to holidays. This fall, class will not meet October 21 or November 25.

For children ages 0-5. Meet new friends when you come to this play group for fun, art and play activities. Bring comfy shoes for time outside while the weather is nice!

Appointments typically run about an hour, and both the child and parent need to be present. Screening results are based on your child's chronological age. **There is no pass or fail!** It is best to screen when a child turns three, but screening can also be done at age four or five.

# DID YOU KNOW?

- Early Child Screening is a check up on how your child is growing and developing.
- All children in Minnesota must be screened before they start kindergarten.
- Screening helps connect your family and child to community resources.

# FARIBAULT PUBLIC SCHOOLS EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM:

The Early Intervention program is part of District 656's Special Education Services. It is a free program offered to families whose child, specifically those from 0 to 3 years old, is eligible and has qualified through our evaluation process. Team members could include an early childhood teacher, a physical therapist, an occupational therapist, and/or a speech therapist.

**OUR MISSION:** The mission of the Faribault Early Intervention EQIP team is to develop and put into practice the skills that will empower and assist families in helping their children to grow and learn in the most meaningful ways in their natural environment.

EQIP or Evidence-based Quality Intervention Practices is an approach or strategy where the caregiver guides the visit; working within typical routines and interests of the child to enhance their child's skills in order to make positive gains towards his/her outcomes. The early childhood team members are there to teach, guide, and coach families or caregivers to help support the development of the child in routine or everyday activities that the caregivers have identified as a need. This evidence based practice is part of ongoing research for providers to use to facilitate caregiver's interactions with their children that promote participation and engagement in their everyday routines. Children learn throughout their day as they experience their day such as getting dressed, mealtime, playtime, naps, bedtime or going to the store. Providers work with the caregivers to embed learning into these daily activities so that it occurs naturally and often.



Children develop in certain, predictable ways, referred to as developmental milestones. Milestones help you understand how your child develops, learns and grows. Visit Help Me Grow to learn more or make a referral to connect with one of our birth to three team specialists.

# FOUR YEAR OLDS \\\\

Falcon's Nest Four Year Old Preschool is a nine-month program that gives students opportunities to meet and play with other children while learning important Kindergarten skills in a play-based classroom setting. Instruction is aligned with Minnesota Early Childhood Indicators of Progress for four-year olds. Beginning math and literacy skills are introduced using the Our World of Learning (OWL) curriculum. Children learn how to problem-solve and navigate emotions with guidance from adults trained in a proactive social-emotional curricular model, intergrating Pyramid model in all classes. Licensed teachers track development and support each student's unique needs.

AGE REQUIREMENT: 4 years old on or before 9/1/2021

**SCHOOL SITES:** Preference given to students residing within school boundaries; Classes held at McKinley Early CHildhood Center, Jefferson Elementary & Roosevelt Elementary.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation is provided for all children living in the Faribault city limits and is included in the price of tuition.
