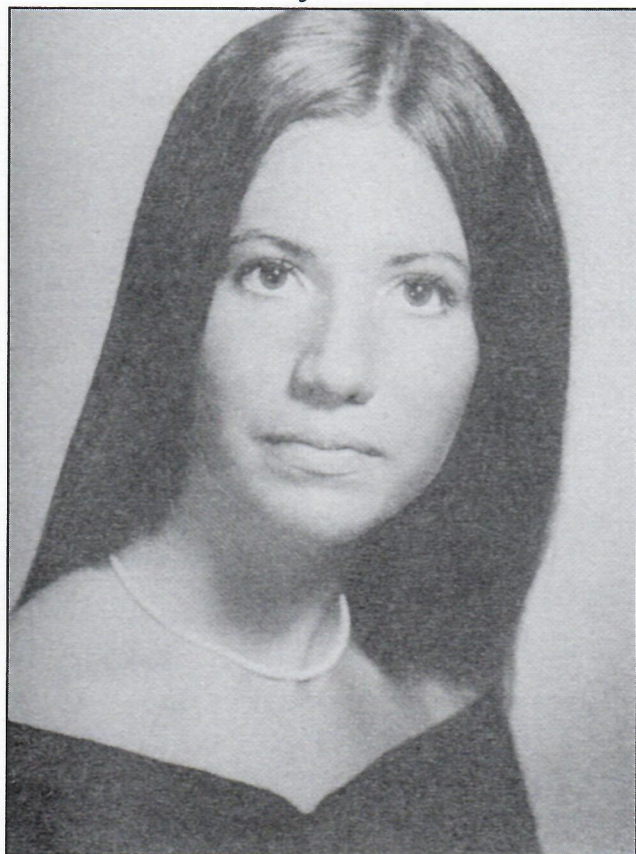

Attracted to the piano since she was 3 years old, Carol Comune is still “mesmerized by the sounds, touch, repertoire and the ability to express one’s sentiments, passions and love all in one.” Indeed, since 1973, Carol Comune has taught, coached, and accompanied hundreds of students, many of whom have been recipients of achievement awards, winners of competitions for performance, and placement in schools and conservatories. She, herself, has the reputation as one of today’s’ premiere pianists, performing extensively throughout the eastern United States.

Carol, a graduate of the New England Conservatory of Music in Boston, has also taught at the Music Prep School and at the Berklee College of Music, the New School of Music, and Northeastern University, as well as at Palm Beach Atlantic College and Lynn University, both of which are in Florida. She teaches in the Honors Music Program at Westminster Conservatory in Princeton and has been a featured artist in concerts locally, at Steinway Hall and Lincoln Center, music director, composer, publisher, recording artist, and teacher.

Carol Comune founded the Comune Music Press in Easton, Pennsylvania and in Jupiter, Florida, which features compositions from baroque to New Age to original, and garnered “rave reviews” from music educators, public radio hosts, music publishers. She conducts seminars and has organized concerts, special events and concert series from Florida to New England. She says of her busy life, “It never feels like a job...it’s my vocation!”
