

# 3D Printing Policy

The 3D printer may be used only for lawful purposes. Students will not be permitted to use the 3D printer to create material that is:

- Prohibited by local, state or federal law. Property or material belonging to another person or entity without their permission.
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others.
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment, including weapons.
- In violation of another's intellectual property rights. For example, the printers will not be used to reproduce material that is subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection.
- Any item designated not appropriate by the library staff.
- **Students are solely responsible for any violation of copyright, patent or trademark laws. Need help determining if you have permission to use a design? Click [HERE](#).**
- The Library reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.

The Library cannot guarantee that a print job will be completed within a particular time frame.

The Library cannot guarantee and is not liable for the final appearance of 3D printed objects.

Prints must meet all of the following criteria:

- Under 4 hours to print
- Fit within the dimensions of 255 mm x 155 mm x 170 mm
- 20% infill
- One color
