

Drew Charter School COVID-19 Weekly Case Report

When Drew Charter School nurses are notified of a confirmed-positive COVID-19 case, they submit a form to the Atlanta Public Schools (APS) Health Services department. APS shares these case reports with the Georgia Department of Public Health each Friday, and the reports are also used for monitoring and tracking of cases and outbreaks within Drew and within the district. When a positive case is reported amongst Drew students or staff or in an extra-curricular environment, COVID-19 protocols go into effect.

The below summary includes self-reported cases and presumptive positives from surveillance testing of COVID-19 (and associated exposures) reported in the last week among students and staff screened through on-campus drive-through testing or who have been on Drew's Elementary Academy or Junior/Senior Academy campus.

Note: Blanks indicate that no data were submitted, while 0s indicate that the Drew nurse(s) confirmed no cases. A case is defined as an individual with a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 positive from either antigen (rapid) or PCR (nasal swab) tests; positive cases are self-reported. Exposures are the close contacts of cases from school, work, and extracurricular settings. Exposures are aggregated from individual case reports and may not represent unique exposures.
