

## TULOSO-MIDWAY ISD ❖ COVID UPDATE, JULY 30, 2021

Recognizing that COVID cases are on the rise in our community, TMISD has requested additional guidance from the Nueces County Health Department (NCHD).

In cooperation with Annette Rodriguez, NCHD Director of Public Health, TMISD will be **offering COVID vaccines for TMISD students 12 years old and above.**

If you would like your age-eligible student to receive the vaccine, at no cost to you, please read and **complete the COVID vaccination forms and send them with your child.** This information can be found at the TMISD website ([www.tmid.edu](http://www.tmid.edu)) at the [COVID](#) link.

NCHD staff will be available to administer vaccines on **Monday, August 2 and Tuesday, August 3** at the locations and times below -

In addition, also recommended by the Nueces County Health Department, TMISD will be providing information regarding the number of COVID cases amongst our staff and students. **Each Friday the number of COVID positive cases, reported to us for the week, will be posted** on the TMISD website ([www.tmid.edu](http://www.tmid.edu)), at the [COVID](#) link. *Please keep in mind the unstable nature of this situation and the fact that not all positive cases are reported to us, this number may not be exact.*

We need your help to attempt to minimize/reduce the spread of COVID and all illnesses. Please **do not send your child to school if they are sick, test positive for COVID or if they should be under quarantine** due to exposure to COVID. Students must be fever-free for at least 24 hours without the help of medication before returning to school.
