

Mustang Madness Fall 2021 Course Descriptions Semester 1

Arts (Thursdays: Grades 1-3; min 4 /max 8 students)

Students will be working with a variety of mediums such as paint, chalk, pastels, wood, fabric and more. We will create some beautiful art during this time. Come explore your creativity after school with Mrs. Goodyear.

Mixed Media (Tuesdays: Grades 4-6; min 4/max 8 students)

Students will explore a variety of media in this class. They will work with clay, create sculptures, draw, paint, paper mache and other exciting materials. Ms. Prince will guide you in creative exploration.

Science (Tuesdays: Grades 4-6 ;min 4/max 8 students)

Come and explore some fun and exciting science experiments. Each week will be something new, with hands-on experimentation that encourages children to “do science” not just watch it. Lava lamp creation, egg drop, slime and much more. Mrs. Kilzer will guide your exploration.

Sewing (Tuesdays: Grades 3-6; min 4/max 8 students)

Come and learn how to sew or further your sewing knowledge with Mrs. Desai. She will introduce you to a variety of fun and unique projects with a historical twist to them.

Yoga (Mondays: Grades 4-6: min 3/max 6 students) (Tuesdays: Grades 1-3; min 3/max 6 students)

Come and learn to stretch and relax your body and mind with our wonderful yoga instructor, Jordan. He will teach you about mindfulness and include a healthy snack at the end of class.

Tae Kwon Do (Thursdays: Grades 1-6: min 6/max 8 students)

Come join the fun, fast paced class and learn the kicks and blocks of the martial art. You will learn self-control and discipline as well as gain self-confidence while participating. The uniforms are an additional 35\$.

Coding Foundations (Mondays: Grades 1-3; min 4/max8 students)

Learn computer science concepts like sequencing, conditionals, loops and functions through a series of fun and interactive exercises on the Kodable platform.

Roblox Studio Coding (Thursdays: Grades 4-6; min 4/max 8 students)

A great way to learn about video game creation, including creating their own characters and game artifacts, employing scripting logic and making games interactive and social.
