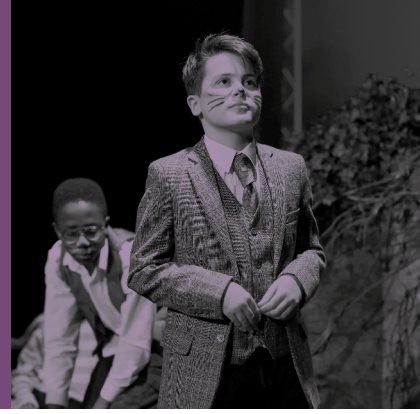


WHITGIFT

- > **13+/14+/16+ Friday 8 October 2021**

Once academically assessed, selected candidates will be invited to Whitgift for an audition. At the audition candidates will be asked to perform two, 2-minute monologues. One should be a classical piece from Shakespeare, or one of his contemporaries, and the other piece should be from a contemporary play written after 1956.
