First Day of School



Our first day of school for students is August 6, 2021 and we are so excited to see them return! Since teaching and learning begin day 1 at McLaurin Elementary School, only our Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students may be walked to class by parents and family members. This gives our teachers a chance to start off strong with all the wonderful lessons they have prepared to engage your students!

We are however, so excited to be opening our doors again this year to family members with our Meet the Teacher night on August 5, 2021.

This is a night our staff has set aside to meet with you and your student, and is a great time to drop off school supplies, see the classroom, and take that Back to School picture with your student's teacher.

Remember, residency information and registration must be complete for students to be placed on a class roll! We ask that all registration be completed by August 3rd so we are able to ensure our class rolls are complete. We look forward to seeing you at our Meet the Teacher Night!

Reminders for the First Day of School:

- Only Pre-K and Kindergarten students may be walked to class as this is their first school experience. If students are new or do not know where their classroom is, we have staff on hand to escort them. Staff can also take school supplies to classes for students.
- Registration must be completed for students to be placed on class rolls.
- There will be no breakfast served on the first day of school. Please plan accordingly. Breakfast will be served beginning Monday, August 9, 2021.
- The office will not be able to take residency documents or register new students until after 9:30 a.m. on August 6, 2021. This is to ensure a safe start to school for all students.
- If you or a family member is experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 or have tested positive, please call the office at (601) 845-2127 before sending students to school.
- Lunch will be served on the first day of school!
