Accreditation

Admissions

Grace Brethren Jr/Sr High has approximately 306 students in grades 7-12. Senior Class Size: 59

- 2. Be submissive to the policies and procedures set forth by Grace Brethren Church and Schools.
- 3. Have parents/guardians who support the philosophy and educational process of Grace Brethren Schools, its administration, teachers, and staff.

Graduation Requirements

- A total of 270 units with a minimum GPA of 2.0 are required for Grace Brethren High School graduation.
- Grace Brethren Jr/Sr High School assigns 5 units of credit per course each semester.
- 12th Grade students must successfully complete the following credits to receive a diploma from GBS: Bible (40), English (40), Mathematics (minimum of 30), Social Sciences (35), Science (30), Foreign Language (20), P.E (10), Visual Performing Art (10), Expository Composition (5) and Critical Thinking & Composition (5), Elective Units (45).

Grace Brethren High School does NOT rank students.

AP Classes: 17 AP classes are offered in 9th-12th grades. Approximately 75% of eligible 11th and 12th grade students take at least one AP class and the corresponding AP exam.
