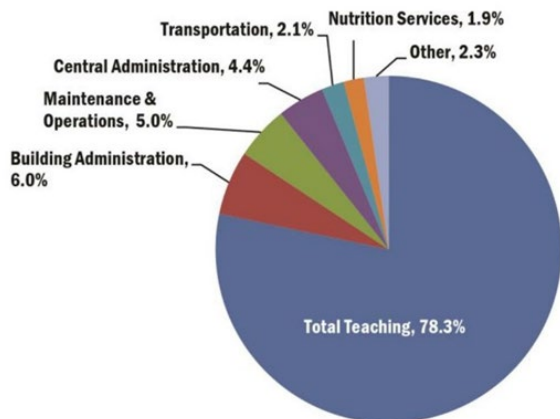
School Description

Where does the money go?



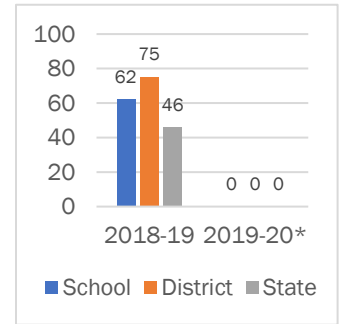
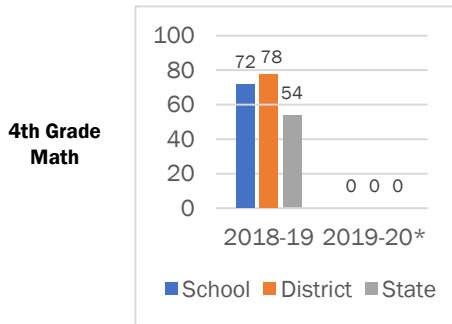
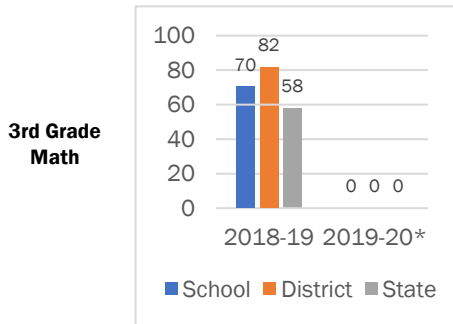
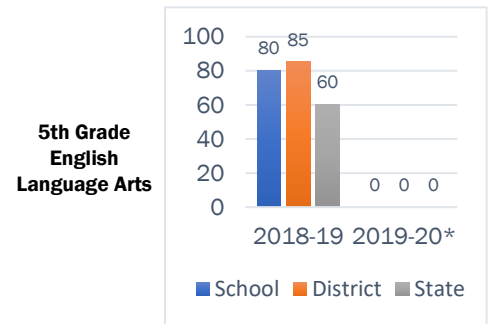
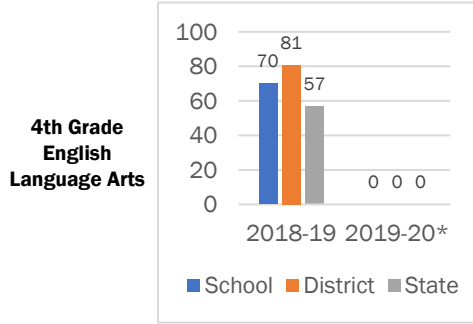
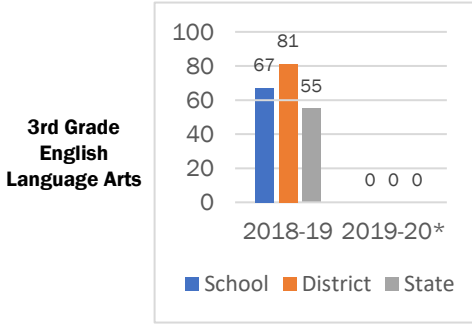
2019 20 School Goals

Staff members worked in grade level teams and teams involving several grades to analyze data and identify where students currently are performing and what progress they could make by the end of the year.

- Grades K-2 Reading: 77.7% of students will be proficient as measured by end of year DIBELS scores
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 80.3% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 77.3% at standard
- Grade 5 Science: 75% at standard
- Achievement gap: 66% of our Hispanic students will meet standard on SBA and DIBELS.
- School Effectiveness: By June 2018 90% of staff agree mostly or completely that all students respect those who are different from them as measured by the Nine Characteristics Survey.
- Attendance: Increase average daily attendance rate from 95.73% to 97%
- Discipline: Decrease the average number of office visits per month from 23 to 10.

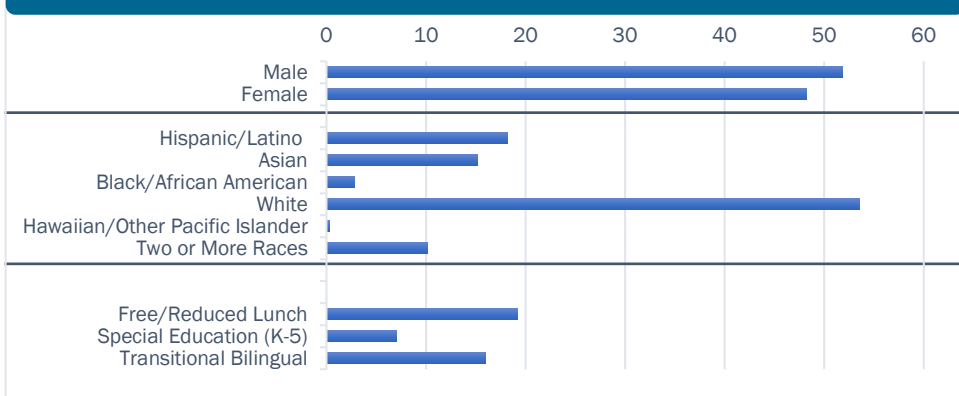
State Assessment Results
