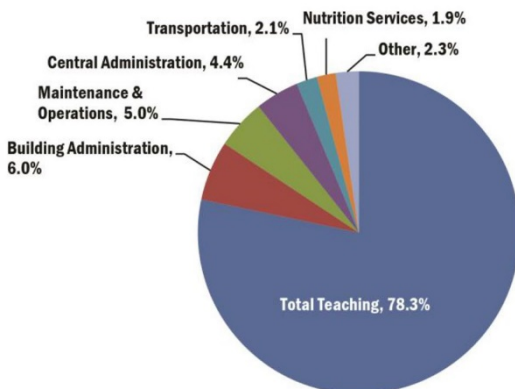
School Description

Finn Hill staff and students emphasize student learning, future readiness and personal growth. Personalization is our hallmark as illustrated by the PRIDE Ambassador orientation program for new students, New Family Night to link FHMS staff, PTSA, and PRIDE Ambassador leaders to new students and their families. Personalization continues through the school year by embedding PRIDE Ambassador leaders in homeroom (called Falcon Time).

We promote family participation through *Skyward*, our web-based online grading and reporting system, PowerSchool Learning (to find teachers' websites), and FHMS/PTSA-hosted education nights on a variety of issues ranging from tracking grades and helping students organize to anti-bullying.

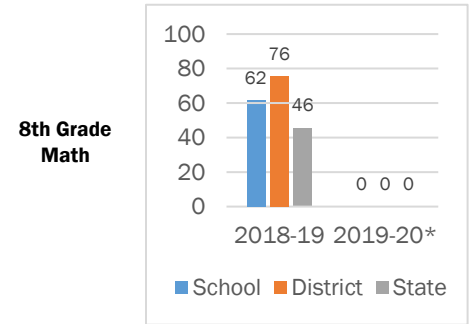
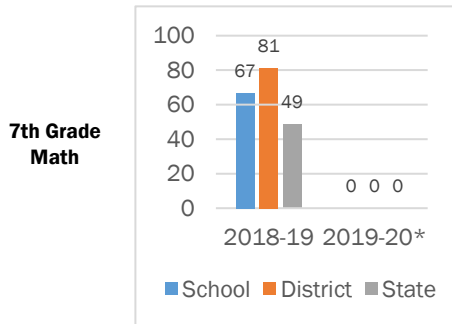
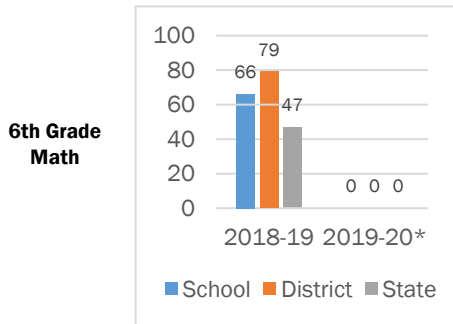
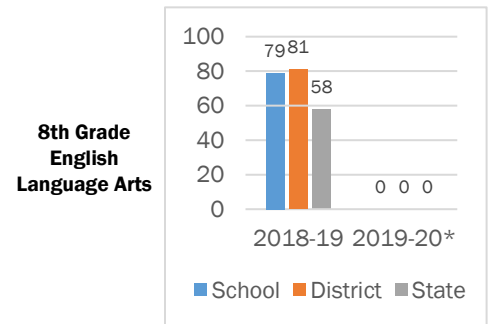
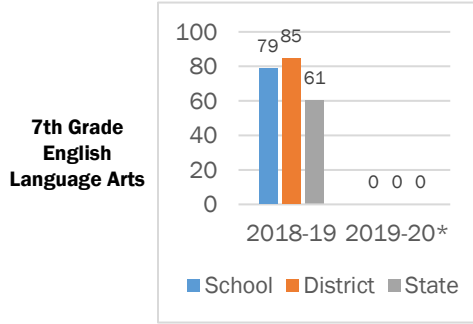
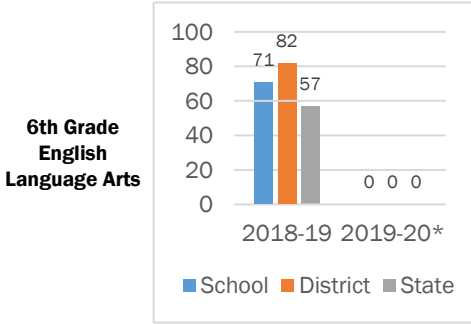


2019 20 School Goals

- Grades 6-8 English Language Arts (ELA): 78% of students at standard
- Grades 6-8 Math: 70% of students at standard
- Grade 8 science: 98% at standard
- Achievement gap: 42% of students identified as low income will meet or exceed standard on the Spring 2019 Math Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA),
- College & Career Readiness: 98% of 8th grade students will complete the required components of Xello.
- School Effectiveness: 80% of staff will agree completely or agree mostly that staff keep the school's goals in mind when making important decisions.
- Attendance: Reduce the overall unexcused absence rate to less than 5%.
- Discipline: All discipline administered in classrooms and by school leadership will involve restorative discipline practices appropriate for each situation.

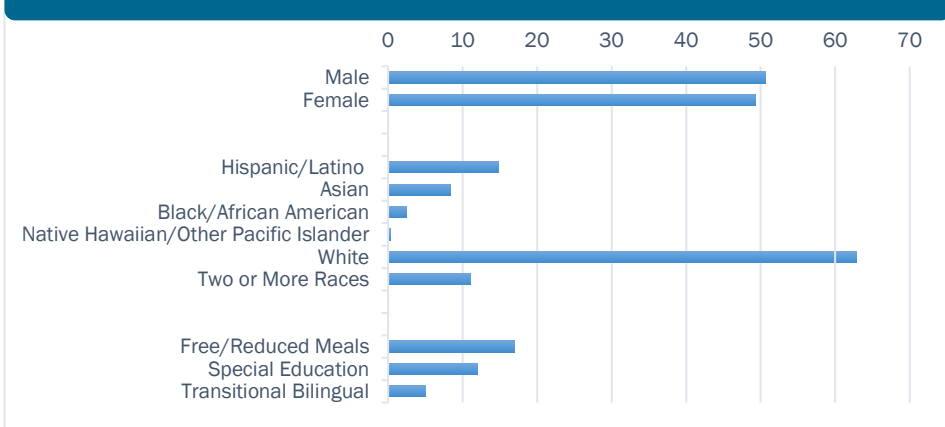
State Assessment Results
