As an American international school, TASIS England fosters a passion for learning by providing a challenging academic experience for day and boarding students from around the world. In our student-centered, supportive environment we help each child discover their individual talents. Our faculty's passion for teaching inspires an enthusiasm for learning, and students benefit from individualized attention in small classes.

Above and beyond academic achievement, the School promotes the development of character, strong values, communication skills, and confidence. English-as-an-Additional Language (EAL) support is available throughout the School to foster the rapid acquisition of reading, writing, and speaking skills. Taught by specialized instructors, the program ensures that non-native English speakers achieve the level of fluency required to thrive in academic subjects.

Upper School (ages 14–18)

Our Upper School students can choose different academic paths:

 International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme – a comprehensive two-year curriculum followed by students in their final two years of school that is accepted by universities around the world.



• Advanced Placement (AP) courses – college-level courses that follow a curriculum set by the American College Board. AP exam results are accepted by universities around the world.

• American College-Prep Curriculum – a comprehensive program of study that includes all of the subjects required for admission to American colleges and universities.

One-to-one university counseling assists our students through every step of the selection and application process. TASIS graduates gain acceptance to excellent universities in the UK, the US, and worldwide.

Boarding Life

Almost half of our Upper School students live on campus in boarding houses supervised by a dynamic TASIS boarding team who are committed to making the residential experience safe, friendly, warm, and caring. The boarding program encourages and supports students as they gain independence, respect, and resilience through the development of lifelong relationships and shared experiences. We go beyond academic achievement and promote each student's self-confidence and leadership potential, while nurturing a sense of individual and community responsibility.

Students form lifelong friendships as they live and work together, and participate in the wide range of weekend activities available. Rooms are typically shared between two or three students, each with a different mother tongue to encourage the use of English and to share and celebrate the diversity within our global community. All meals are provided, and the on-campus Health Centre ensures that nursing care is available if required.









MIDDLE SCHOOL (AGES 10–14)

During these transitional years, students need guidance and understanding as they change and grow from childhood to adolescence. Students follow a full schedule of core courses (English, Mathematics, Science, French or Spanish, and History and Geography) along with additional subjects that include Technology, Art, Music, Drama, and Physical Education, as well as several other optional courses.



The Middle School house system provides many opportunities for students to develop leadership and collaborative skills as they work, play, and socialize with their peers in friendly competitions, charity fund-raising, and community activities. The sports program is designed to encourage participation and skills development.

LOWER SCHOOL (AGES 3–10)

The Lower School curriculum is designed to foster the creativity and natural curiosity of young students. The core subjects – Literacy, Mathematics, Science, History and Geography – are supplemented by specialist classes such as Spanish, Technology, Art, Music, Drama, and Physical Education. Educational excursions and field trips complement and enhance the academic program. As the children learn to work together in the classroom and socialize with their peers in after-school activities, they are guided by the School's emphasis on Core Virtues such as respect, responsibility, honesty, generosity, and perseverance.



Within the Lower School area of campus, the children have their own dining room and playground, a well-resourced library, a dedicated science center, and a MakerSpace classroom designed for exploration of the STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics) subjects.

EXTRACURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES

ASIS England's 46-acre campus provides excellent facilities for its comprehensive program of competitive and recreational sports and diverse artistic pursuits, drama productions, and musical performances. Students participate in engaging after-school activities such as music, art, drama, robotics, recreational sports, and student-led clubs and organizations. Conveniently located near London, the School uses the UK and Europe as extensions of the classroom and gives students of all ages many opportunities for cultural excursions and travel.



Our students also participate in leadership and community service programs, developing an understanding of the importance of service to others.

PARENT COMMUNITY

TASIS England views education as a partnership between the School and the family. Parents are active and involved in the life of the School, from volunteering to help in the Lower School Library to baking cakes for boarding students' birthday celebrations. New families are warmly welcomed and quickly make friends as they integrate into the school community.
