DAVIE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
TUESDAY, JULY 6, 2021

The Davie County Board of Education met at 4:00 p.m., July 6, 2021, in the Board Room of the Central Davie Education Center, 220 Martin Luther King Jr. Road, Mocksville, NC.

Chairman Junker called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. Chairman Junker offered the invocation then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

David Carroll made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

Dub Potts made the motion, seconded by Cammie Webb, to approve the minutes of the June 1, 2021 regular Board of Education meeting and the June 7, 2021 special called Board of Education meeting/work session as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

Board Report

Chairman Junker reviewed upcoming events starting with the next Board of Commissioners Meeting being held Monday, July 12, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. The Davie County Schools Administrator Retreat will be July 20-21, 2021 at Davie County High School. The next Board of Education meeting will be Tuesday, August 3, 2021 with a start time of 4:00 p.m. and closed session at the end of the meeting. The first day of school for Davie County Early College High School is August 5, 2021. Davie County Schools will hold their annual convocation on Friday, August 20 at 8:30 a.m. at Davie County High School gymnasium. The first day of school for Davie County Schools will be Tuesday, August 24, 2021.

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Superintendent's Report

Mr. Wallace began his report by congratulating the Davie County High School Class of 2021 who graduated on June 5, 2021. Mr. Wallace stated that Mr. Nicholson, current principal of Davie County High School will be retiring at the end of July 2021. Michael Pruitt, the current principal of North Davie Middle School, has been named the new Davie County High School principal.

Over the past 2020-2021 school year, Mr. Wallace reported that 751,946 screenings were performed. There were 505 staff members and 40 students that were between the ages of 16-18 years old that were vaccinated at the vaccine clinics held at Davie County High School. A total of 116 staff members and 340 students tested positive for COVID. The attendance rate at the end of the 2020-2021 school year was 93.3% compared to the end of the 2018-2019 school year attendance rate of 94.69%.

Mr. Wallace shared information from the ABC Collaborative group who said 1) the vaccine works, and 2) when everyone wears a mask it prevents the spread of COVID. Information regarding the start of school is expected to be in the NC Toolkit within the next two weeks. Mr. Wallace brought up that the federal government is providing funds to perform weekly COVID testing for staff and students. The tests are not mandated but would be available for anyone who wants to participate.

Summer school began June 14 and will end July 15, 2021. Students have been engaged during summer school as well as the staff. There are approximately 675 students attending summer school.

Mr. Wallace shared that Davie County Schools put a request for qualifications notice for K Building in local newspapers with a deadline of July 15, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. for any companies wanting to turn in a qualifications package. The committee that will determine which companies to interview includes Mr. Wallace, Michael Spillman, Clay Harris, Anthony Davis, Dub Potts, and David Carroll. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for Thursday, July 22, 2021. The committee will bring their recommendation to the August 3, 2021 board of education meeting.

There will be a board retreat on Friday, October 1, 2021. More details will be provided at a later date.

Lastly, Mr. Wallace shared that Jinda Haynes, Jeremy Miller, and others have been busy trying to recruit people for positions that need to be filled within the school district. Mindy and Jesse Ledbetter helped decorate a golf cart to look like a school bus for staff to drive in the Mocksville and Cooleemee Fourth of July parades. Jeremy Miller also drove a Davie County Schools yellow bus in each parade.

Recognitions

Mr. Dub Potts presented a Superintendent's Plaque with all the past superintendents' names on it and the years they served as superintendent or interim superintendent. The past superintendents who had representation at the meeting were Mr. James Everidge, Dr. Robert Landry, Mr. Dub Potts, and Dr. Darrin Hartness. There will be two plaques that will be displayed at Central Davie Education Center in the boardroom and at Davie County Schools Central Office.

Mr. Doyle Nicholson recognized Mr. Perry Long for being selected as the 2020-2021 Central Piedmont Conference Wrestling Coach of the Year.

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Mr. Perry Long recognized his 2020-2021 Davie County High School Wrestling Team which won the Central Piedmont Conference Championship. Mr. Long also shared that Collin Bailey and Isaac Webb were selected as Central Piedmont Conference Wrestlers of the Year in lower weight and upper weight respectively. Mr. Long also recognized Jack Jarvis who won the 2020-2021 4A State Championship at the 170-pound weight class.

Consent Agenda

Lori Smith made the motion, seconded by David Carroll, to approve the consent items as presented. The motion carried 6-0. Consent items approved: Milk Bid Award for SY 2021-2022, Misadministration Report, Budget Amendments, Donations Report, Public School Building Capital Fund NC Education Lottery Usage, and Personnel Recommendations.

Business Items

Mr. Wallace presented the policy revisions for approval. David Carroll made the motion to approve the policy revisions as presented. Dub Potts seconded the motion; the motion carried 6-0.

Public Address to the Board

Attorney Sarah Saint explained the procedures for public comments. One individual signed up to speak before the board. That person was allowed five minutes to speak.

1. Matt Johnson- Mr. Johnson stated that masks have psychological effects and are detrimental to student learning. He said he cannot find any data for schools who required no masks and their COVID-19 infection rate. He asked, where is that data? Mr. Johnson says COVID is over. There is no reason to push for the vaccine for children when the CDC themselves say it's dangerous for children. Mr. Johnson would like for the Board of Education to have an emergency meeting and make an informed decision to unmask our children for the upcoming school year.

Closed Session

Chairman Junker called for a motion to go into closed session to preserve the attorney client privilege pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(3) to discuss personnel matters protected by State law and N.C.G.S.143-318.11(a)(6); to discuss student matters made confidential by N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(1), G.S. 115C-402 and FERPA. Lori Smith made the motion, seconded by Cammie Webb; the motion carried 6-0. The Board went into closed session at 4:47 p.m.

Return to Open Session

The board returned from closed session to open session at 5:19 p.m.


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Adjourn
