Check In



Our student check in event for 2021-2022 is next week! This is an optional event with the primary focus being student photos.

Each day a different grade is asked to stop by school to have their photo taken for their student badge. The photographers will be available from 8:00am to 3:00pm in the CHS Student Center. Please follow this schedule:

Tuesday, August 3	Freshmen
Wednesday, August 4	Sophomores
Thursday, August 5	Juniors
Friday, August 6	Seniors

In addition to student photos, students/families may:

- Purchase parking permits - seniors and juniors only (complete the application and pay your fee ahead of time!)
- Drop off [student health forms](#) and medications
- Arrange for repair for district Chromebooks. Please bring the device and charging cord. It is highly recommended that you arrange for repairs now so that your Chromebook can be repaired before classes start.
- Pick up Chromebook for students in grades 10 - 12 who are new to Centaurus / BVSD (Chromebook pick up for students in grade 9 is scheduled for the first day of school.)

***Student schedules will not be available at the Check In - the district will release these on Infinite Campus later in August.**

*The Check In is the best opportunity for students to have their photo taken for badges and yearbook, but a make up photo day will be scheduled for later in fall semester.

*Students needing school supplies and/or backpacks may pick up these items at the Check In. This effort was made possible through a generous donation from Impact on Education!

*Most paperwork and fee payments may all be handled online.

- Please complete the [Annual Data Update within Infinite Campus](#). This update is required for all returning BVSD students.
- The RevTrak system has been updated and standardized across schools. Parents may create one new account to access all their BVSD students' fees even if they attend multiple BVSD schools. [You may pay fees with a credit card through this system.](#)
