Barbers Hill Independent School District is a suburban district in western Chambers County. Established in 1929, the district has a rich tradition of community involvement and school pride. 




Our students in 2019

The starting salary for a BHISD teacher is \$56,742 with the average teacher salary reaching \$68,072. Our teachers average 14 years of experience. BHISD has the largest percentage of National Board Certified Teachers in Texas, with 33 current NBCTs.





Finance at a glance

- Barbers Hill ISD has earned an "A" (Superior) in the Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas since the system's inception (16 years).
- Because BHISD is classified as a property-wealthy district, it is required to send about 1/4 of local tax revenue to the State of Texas in a process known as "recapture."
- BHISD homeowners pay one of the lowest tax levies of all public schools in the Houston area after all qualifying exemptions are applied.
- BHISD taxpayers over the age of 65 have the most favorable homestead exemption in the state.
- Of BHISD's local tax revenue, 84¢ of each \$1 comes from local industry. By contrast, homeowners pay about 16¢ of each \$1.
- Barbers Hill leads the state in economic development initiatives, adding 450 jobs & \$13.6 billion in taxable value to our community.


\$2,840,936 of the total state funding is the State of Texas' share of teacher retirement funds for local employees. The district receives very little federal funding, primarily to reimburse it for Medicaid-covered in-school services to special-needs students.

- In 2018, the number of innovative grants awarded was 71
