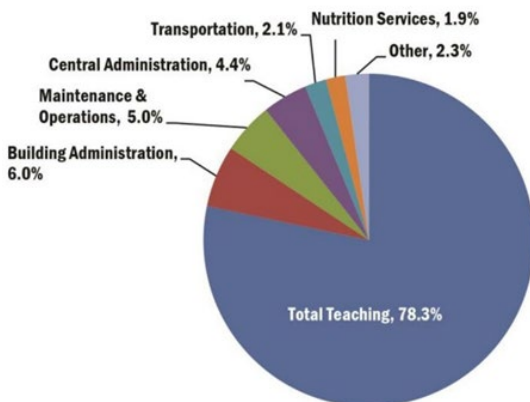

PTSA enrichment programs continue to compliment the work of our teachers.

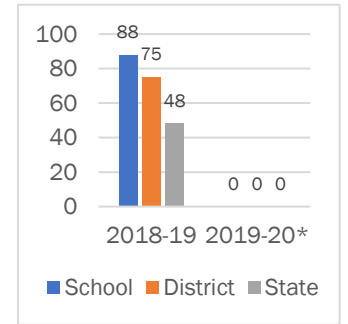
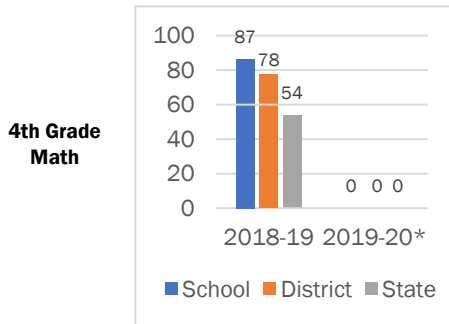
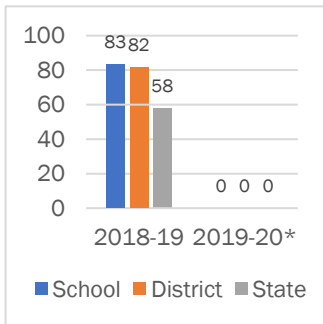
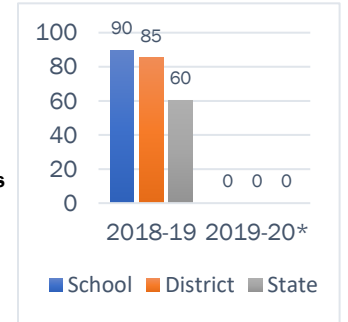
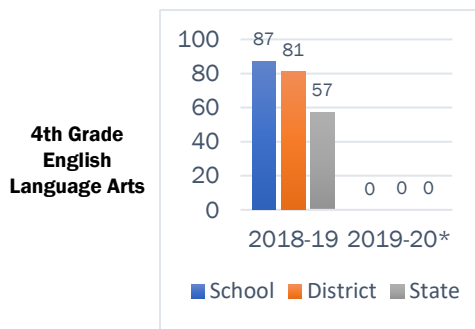
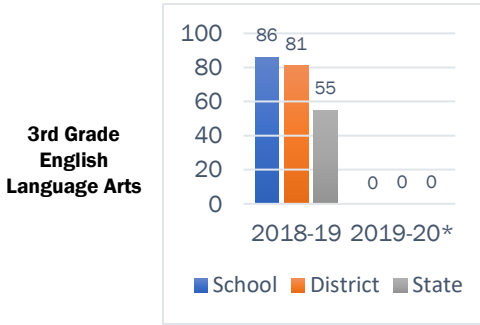
2019 20 School Goals

Teachers examined assessment data to determine school goals. Teachers met to discuss strategies to be used to increase performance in academic areas. Goals are monitored regularly.

- Grades K-2 Reading: 88% of students at standard on the end of year DIBELS
- Grades 3-5 English Language Arts: 88% at standard
- Grades 3-5 Math: 89% at standard
- Grade 5 Science: 594% at standard
- Achievement gap: 100% of students receiving English Language Learner services K-2 at standard
- School Effectiveness: 80% of Baker certificated staff will agree mostly or completely that they receive regular feedback as measured by the Nine Characteristics survey (question 42).
- Attendance: We will reduce the number of student tardies from 2% to 1%, as measured by monthly attendance records
- Discipline: 80% of Ella Baker certificated staff will agree mostly or completely that student discipline problems are managed well as measured by the Nine Characteristics survey in 2019.

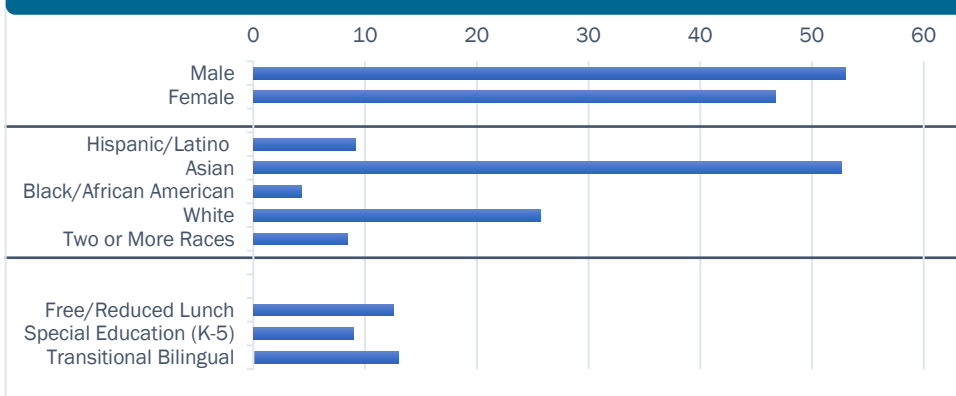
State Assessment Results
