If you are interested in School Based Mental Health counseling services, please see the Referral Process below and access referral forms at

- Referrals can be made by the Student, Parent, Teacher, School Counselor, or Admin
- Teacher, School Counselor, or Admin completes referral form that is specific to the Service Provider and emails the completed form to the Provider's point of contact and will cc the principal
- Service Provider confirms receipt of the referral with referring staff
- Counselor or Therapist contacts parent/guardian for consent to begin mental health services
 - Students 12 years or older can consent for their own counseling per [SB 543](#) coupled with [Family Code § 6924](#) & [Health & Safety Code § 124260](#) after therapists consult with supervisor
- Counselor or Therapist will make several attempts to contact the family and communicate updates with the admin, teacher, school counselor
- Counselor or Therapist coordinates an in-person or phone/video counseling session with student
