Uniform Dress Code Policy 2020-21

<p>Shirts/Blouses: Red, Black, Light Blue, or Navy Blue: Shirts may be solid color polo, henley, or t-shirts with <u>NO</u> designs, prints, art work, or slogans. When planning for cooler weather, purchase long sleeve shirts, sweatshirts, or turtlenecks in Red, Black, Light Blue, or Navy Blue.</p>
<p>Pants: Black, Navy, or Khaki pants – Jeans (blue or black) are not to be worn unless a special dress day has been announced from the school office.</p>
<p>Shorts: Black, Navy, or Khaki shorts (longer length, please – not running shorts)</p>
<p>Belts: Required for all pants and shorts – no sagging pants! Kindergarten and 1st grade students are not required to wear belts.</p>
<p>Jumpers/Dresses/Skirts: Black, Navy, or Khaki (longer length)</p>
<p>Leggings/Pilates pants: These tight-fitting items may only be worn under a skirt/dress as tights – they are NEVER to be worn as the only bottom garment.</p>
<p>Socks/Tights: Knee socks or crew socks (any color); tights (any color)</p>
<p>Sweatshirts, Sweaters, or Cardigans: Red, White, Light Blue, Navy Blue or Black with <u>NO</u> designs, print, art work or slogans.</p>
<p>Shoes: Athletic shoes are the safest shoe to wear during the school day. Please do not wear high heels, fashion boots, flip-flops, sandals, crocs, or roller-shoes.</p>
<p>Headwear: Hats, hoods, scarves, bandanas, athletic headbands are not to be worn in the building.</p>
<p>Spring Creek Spirit Wear: (T-shirts, sweatshirts, fleece) may be worn on <u><i>Mondays, Wednesday, and Fridays.</i></u> Uniform bottoms should be worn on those days. Spirit wear can be purchased online at https://stores.inksoft.com/spring_creek_elementary</p>
<p>Our Spirit Wear provider is Embroid This in Machesney Park.</p>
<p>No Uniform Days will be announced throughout the school year. On these special dress days, students must wear school-appropriate clothing.</p>
<p>Blue jeans are not to be worn unless a special dress day has been announced from the school office.</p>

School uniforms are carried at many stores in the area - uniform clothing items may be purchased wherever you choose. The school does not have uniforms for sale; however, the school does stock gently used uniforms for student emergencies. If you would like to donate gently used uniforms, please bring them to the school office.
