Senior Modification (Mod) Dress Code

Senior Modification (Mod) Dress Code is a privilege granted to the Senior Class and is a modification of the uniform that distinguishes these students as mature and responsible adults preparing to enter the college and business world. The guidelines for Senior Mod are given in writing to the Senior class the summer before senior year begins.

Seniors may choose to wear the school uniform in lieu of Senior Mod. All students are required to wear the Standard St. Andrew's Schools Uniform on chapel days and other designated days. Uniforms or Senior Mod must be worn when attending classes at UH or HPU. Senior Mod is worn to Senior Internship. Violation of the Senior Mod will result in consequences.

The administrative staff establishes the guidelines for Senior Mod. Exclusion of particular attire from the Senior Mod policy does not indicate that the attire is permissible. Common sense and good conscience should be utilized as guidelines.

Blouses:

- Colors: Black, Grey, White (including cream/off-white), Red (including Priory Red, burgundy, maroon), Tan, Navy Blue, pastel colors in blue or pink
- Styles: professional business style, tailored blouses, sleeves required
- Not allowed: t-shirts, sweatshirts, flannel, exposed midriff, low-cut neck lines, tank tops

Appropriate undergarments, according to the Parent-Student Handbook, are to be worn under the blouse.

Dress Skirts and Pants/Slacks:

- Colors: Black, Grey, Red (includes Priory Red, burgundy, maroon), Tan, Navy Blue
- Patterns (in approved colors above): black pinstripe, houndstooth, small glen plaid
- Styles: Professional business style, pants/slacks must be ankle-length or longer
- Not allowed: cropped pants, spandex/lycra material, skirts shorter than 3" above the knee, in the front and back, when standing

Appropriate undergarments should be worn under skirts and pants.

Blazers and Cardigans:

- Colors: Black, Grey, White (including cream, off-white), Red (including Priory Red, burgundy, and maroon), Tan, Navy Blue
- Balzer Patterns (in approved colors above): black pinstripe, houndstooth, small glen plaid
- Styles: Blazers and cardigans should be well-fitted. Blazers and cardigans should be worn in a way that is tidy and neat.
- Not Allowed: Sloppy, ill-fitting, or oversized blazers and cardigans

Business Style Dresses:

- Colors: Black, Grey, Red (including Priory Red, burgundy, and maroon), Tan, Navy Blue
- Styles: Western Business style dresses, dress length may be no shorter than 3" above the knee, in the front and the back, when standing.
- Not Allowed: Sloppy or ill-fitting dresses, spandex/lycra/sweatshirt/flannel material

Shoes:

- Colors: Black, Tan, White
- Styles: Dress shoes/pumps (max. 2-inches heel), wedges (max. 3-inch heel), flats, oxfords, loafers
- All shoes must have a covered toe.
- Not Allowed: open-toe shoes; dress shoes/pumps with heels higher than 2-inches; wedges higher than 3-inches; shoes, other than oxfords, should not have laces

Accessories:

- Colors: Black, Grey, White (including cream, off white), Red (including Priory Red, burgundy, maroon), Tan, Navy Blue
- Styles: Belts, Ties, Bowties, Suspenders may be worn in only the noted colors above
- Makeup and jewelry are to be worn in accordance with the Parent-Student Handbook.

Violations: If there is a Senior Mod violation, then class officers, faculty and staff, advisor, or Upper School Principal will enforce the following consequences:

- 1st Senior Mod Violation the student loses Senior Mod for a month.
- 2nd Senior Mod Violation the student loses all senior privileges for a month.
- 3rd Senior Mod Violation the student loses Senior Mod for the remainder of the quarter or semester.
