1	Outstanding Student Achievement Award	Brian Siesto shared with the group that the nomination form for Building Council's annual Outstanding Student Achievement Award was sent to all high school parents. The deadline is Friday, May 7 th and to date we have received 7 student nominations, The winner will be announced at our annual SH Awards Night on Tuesday, June 1 st . Since this event will be videoed on Wednesday, May 12 th , an electronic ballot will be sent to all Building Council members so a winner can be determined before the film date.						

2	Full Return to School	<p>Brian Siesto spoke with the group about the potential return of students to the high school a full five days per week. On Monday, April 26th, the Victor Early Childhood School, Victor Primary School, and Victor Intermediate School will all return to a full five days per week model. Victor Junior High and Senior High will not return to this model at this time. At the JH/SH, class sizes in PE, science labs, and the cafeteria do not have enough space to follow the mandated 6 feet separation guidelines. The number of positive Covid cases in the community are analyzed every Wednesday to determine if it is safe to return to a 3 feet separation guideline. If we remain hybrid until May 3rd, a final decision will be made by the district to remain hybrid for the rest of the school year.</p>

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4	End of Year Testing	<p>AP and IB testing will begin next month, there are both digital and paper options. There are usually 11 standard Regents tests in June, this year there are four: Algebra, Living Environment, Earth Science and ELA 11. Students who pass the Regents class can exempt themselves from Regents testing. Students who are not passing the Regents class, need to “opt in” to take the Regents exam. The assumption is that if a student is passing the class, they will pass the exam. If a student is not passing the class, they will need to either attend summer school or retake the class. Students can also have the option of rejecting the grade that they earn on the Regents exam.</p>																
5	Calendars	<p>Brian shared the new May and June ABCD and testing calendars. There will be no final exams this year at the high school but all formal assessments should be completed by Friday, June 11th. The focus of 6/14-6/24 will be on completing work for the school year.</p>
