

There are many preschool options available to families in Eden Prairie, but Little Eagles Preschool program is the only one that aligns with Eden Prairie Schools K-12 curriculum and the overall K-12 system. We work closely with Early Childhood Special Education and kindergarten teachers to foster a successful transition from preschool to kindergarten.

Curriculum Focused on Personalized Learning

We use Creative Curriculum, which is a balanced approach of all social-emotional and academic areas. We focus on personalized learning for your child. TRANSPORTATION FOR 3 YEAR OLDS

Only 3 year olds who attend AM, PM or AM Plus and meet certain eligibility requirements will qualify for transportation.

WHAT IS AM PRESCHOOL + RE?

Little Eagles no longer offers a 6:30 am - 6:00 pm "Full Day Program" but offers a 6 hour, AM Preschool + RE. All students enrolled in the 6 hour program, will have the same academic hours as a preschool session plus Rest and Enrichment. Families can add on Before Preschool Care, After Preschool Care or both Before and After Preschool Care to create a schedule to match their families needs. Enrollment in additional care must align with the child's preschool enrollment.

DO YOU HAVE CARE ON DAYS THERE IS NO SCHOOL?

On most days when school is not in session, we will have non-school day opportunities for enrolled families. More information to come in the upcoming months.

DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BE TOILET TRAINED?

Children should be potty trained or must be actively potty training before entering preschool, meaning they have:

- the ability to identify and verbalize the urge to use the restroom in a timely manner
- the ability to manage all self-help/toileting skills independently
- the ability to manage their preschool day including rest time without a pull-up

We are aware that it is developmentally appropriate for children of this age to have accidents from time to time. In the event that your child needs additional support through toilet training, classroom staff and Parent Educators will work with you and your child.

WHAT IF MY CHILD TURNS 3 AFTER SEPTEMBER 1, 2021?

PRESCHOOL SAMPLER

This class is designed for children to ease into the world of preschool. Children will 'practice' preschool during this drop-off class, available as a one or two day session. Students will strengthen their independence and will be ready to soar as a Little Eagle into preschool. Children must be 3 by the start of class, and actively potty training to enroll in Preschool Sampler.

4 YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD BY SEPT. 1, 2021.

Create a school community connection, reduce transitions and prepare your child for Kindergarten through Little Eagles 4 year old preschool at one of our five Elementary Schools. Through interactive, stimulating and academically rich programming, your child will practice academic, social and emotional skills to prepare for Kindergarten. 4 year old preschoolers will also have lunch as a part of their preschool day. You have the option of bringing a lunch from home or purchasing a school lunch for an additional fee. We have dedicated preschool transportation to and from school for children living within the Eden Prairie School district boundary.

LOCATIONS/BOUNDARY SCHOOLS

4 year old preschool programming has moved to Eden Prairie Schools' five Elementary Schools*.

Can I attend a school other than my boundary school? Priority enrollment will be for students enrolling in their boundary school. Families who choose to send their child to a school other than their boundary school will be given second priority, on a first come, first serve basis. Busing is not provided if a family attends a school outside of their boundary school. Students will not automatically be enrolled for this school for K-12, they must follow the district transfer protocol.

Our older child attends Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion, now what? Proof of a sibling attending Eagle Heights is required to enroll in Oak Point if it is not the boundary school for the family.

Can I open enroll from another district? Yes, pending availability. Open enrollment is based on availability of space in the program. Please contact the Little Eagles office at 952-975-7200 to discuss availability and next steps.

WHAT HAPPENED TO 5K PREP?

The vision and goals of Designing Pathways for 4 Year Old Preschool moving into all Elementary Schools is to create a school community connection, reduce transitions moving into Elementary Schools and to retain families in Eden Prairie Schools. We no longer have one Elementary Site for preschool, but are embracing a Preschool-Grade 5 concept where families and students can start their journey of continued education at their neighborhood school. When you enroll your child who turned 5 in June, July, August or September in an additional year of Little Eagles, our highly qualified Early Childhood Educators will ensure their academic and social-emotional development is nurtured.

LITTLE EAGLES SUMMER CAMP, AGES 3-4

While onsite, students will engage in thematic weeks where they will experience activities aligned to the theme in large motor, science, art, and cooking as well as having ample outdoor time including water days! Scheduled weekly field trips are not being held during Summer 2021. An optional August field trip may be available, pending MN's COVID-19 Safe Learning Plan.

AGES: Students must be at least 3 years old by January 1, 2021. We recommend this program

for students entering preschool in Fall 2021, but will accept students 3-5 years old.

DATES: 2021 summer session will begin on Monday, June 7 and be offered through

Wednesday, August 25, 2021. Closed Friday, July 2nd and Monday July 5th.

All Eden Prairie Schools programming is closed Thursday, August 26-Friday, September

HOURS & LOCATION: Hours are 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM

Located at Lower Campus (8100 School Road)

COST: Cost is \$71 per day for 3-4 days a week and \$65 per day for 5 days a week.

A consistent schedule is required (i.e., same days of the week all summer).

Registration fee is \$75 to reserve your spot.

All Registration and Activity Fees are Non-Refundable.

Add-on drop-in dates can be added if space is available. Cost is \$71 per day and must be

requested at least 3 days prior to care.

DETAILS: You must provide a daily lunch, morning snack and a water bottle. Afternoon snacks are

provided.

A daily rest period is required in each classroom. Duration is 30 minutes - 2 hours,

depending on age of class.

All current school year tuition balances must be paid before attending summer programming.

Information regarding COVID-19 programming decisions will be shared closer to the start of summer programming (masks, contact with other classes, temperature checks, etc).

Family School takes place two days a week at the Lower Campus Preschool building from 9:45 am-12:00 pm; specific days of the week depend on English test scores. Regular attendance is expected.

Families register separately for adult classes, childcare (infant and toddler class), and preschool. Adult classes

and childcare are free; fee assistance or scholarships may be available for preschool. Community Education staff will reach out to you regarding transportation options.

Join us at Early Childhood Screening as soon as your child turns 3! This is a FREE and simple check of how your child is growing and developing. It is a requirement of the State of Minnesota for all preschool-aged children.

WHAT AGE SHOULD MY CHILD BE SCREENED?

If your child is between the ages of 3 and 5, it is time to schedule his/her Early Childhood Screening to check all areas of development including hearing, vision, speech, and motor abilities.

WHERE IS SCREENING HELD?

Screening appointments are held at the Education Center at 8040 Mitchell Road, Eden Prairie.

HOW DO I SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT?

The state of Minnesota requires that all children be screened before they enter kindergarten. Schedule your appointment today:

WHAT DATES ARE SCREENING APPOINTMENTS CURRENTLY AVAILABLE?

Screening appointments are available on various dates and times including evenings. Check our website or call to find out about a date and time that will work for your schedule.

WHAT INFORMATION IS GATHERED AT SCREENING?

Screening questions are tailored specifically to your child's age. Discover more about your child's development and learning, such as:

- Thinking, language, and communication skills
- Social and emotional development
- Large and small muscle coordination
- Height, weight, hearing, and vision

Early Childhood Screening is one way to support children in their early years of growth and development. It is also a way to identify children who may benefit from early childhood special services before they enter school and connects families with the appropriate resources and programs.

WHAT DOES SCREENING COST?

Early childhood screenings are FREE!

RESOURCES FOR FAMILIES

EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIAL EDUCATION

Eden Prairie Schools Community Education works with children of all abilities. Our staff work with enrolled families to provide reasonable accommodations as needed for each child. The goal for all children is to have independent, meaningful participation in the program.

All children participating in programming must consistently demonstrate the ability to follow adult direction, show readiness for large group activities, including the ability to remain with the group, and follow safety rules.

Children need to meet state eligibility criteria in order to receive Early Childhood Special Education services. Questions and concerns regarding your child's development are welcomed. For additional information, contact the Early Childhood Special Education Office at 952-975-6979.

REGISTRATION FAQs

PRESCHOOL CLASS FEE

There is a \$75 non-refundable registration fee for schoolyear preschool classes. Payments are charged on the 1st of the month from September to May.

BIRTH DATE GUIDELINES

For both ECFE and preschool classes, please select your class based on your child's age by Sept. 1, 2021. This age requirement aligns with district kindergarten age requirements.

BIRTH CERTIFICATE

A copy of your child's birth certificate is required for any child participating in ECFE or preschool. They can be emailed to EPS_LittleEagles@edenpr.org or dropped off at the Early Childhood office.

IMMUNIZATION LAW

All students in Minnesota must have immunizations up-to-date and on record with the school before the child starts class. Immunization forms are available online at www.edenpr.org/earlychildhood.

PHOTOS AND VIDEO POLICY

Class participants in our programs may be photographed and filmed for marketing purposes (e.g., website, social media, catalog and flyers). If you would prefer not to have you or your child photographed or filmed please email comed@edenpr.org after registering.

CANCELLATION POLICY FOR PRESCHOOL

Any changes to the child's schedule, including withdrawal from the program, must be given 10 business days prior to when the change is needed. If notice is not given, two weeks of tuition will be charged to the account. A \$20 processing fee is charged for all cancellations and classroom changes. No refunds are given for emergency or weather closings or for days missed due to illness or vacation. Please note, the (\$75) registration fee is non-refundable.

FEE ASSISTANCE FOR PRESCHOOL

Limited tuition assistance is provided for qualifying families through:


